If your children are anything like my 7 and 10 year old boys, this is not likely to be a specific question they would ever think of asking. It isn't their job to ask that question but it's our job as parents to answer it for them, whether they ask it or not. Praying for our children is one of the most important responsibilities we have as parents. So, how should I answer this hypothetical question? I'd like to think I'd say "Yes! Of course, I'd love to". But what would I pray? How can I pray? Why should I pray?

> For the next 14 days, will you join with me as we answer these questions? Will you take at least 15 minutes a day to specifically pray for your children?

In this personalized journal we will have a daily theme, a bible verse, something to consider, a prayer, some discussion questions and some action steps;

READ, CONSIDER, PRAY, ASK, DO.

I've included some room for you to write in the names of your children and space to write your own prayers, answers and notes to make this personal. My prayer for each of us over these 14 days is that we discover that intentional prayers for our children will allow God to empower our kids to become all that He intends them to be.

The final day in this challenge is to pray for our children's salvation. I am not only committing to praying for my own children but for yours too. I'm praying that they, through your prayers, love and guidance, will discover what it means to be in a real and life-changing relationship with their savior, Jesus.

So, on behalf of my children and your children, let me ask for them ... Will you pray for me?

READ

GONSIDER



Will You Pray for My Self-Control?


READ

"Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect." Romans 12:2

GONSIDER

If a parent teaches their children to learn the habit of selfcontrol in childhood, they will practice self-discipline when they are grown.



Will You Pray for My Love for God's Word?

READ

"Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path". Psalms 119:105



GONSIDER

As parents, God entrusts us with the great responsibility and sacred privilege of teaching our children not only about Him, but also how we should live our lives. When our kids have questions about how to handle the daily pressures they face in school, about how they should treat their friends, their classmates, and their parents, about whether something is right or wrong, we have the privilege of leading them, but we also get to teach them to ask God for wisdom and direct them to the Bible for answers.

ASK: When and how often do I read the bible to/with my kids? How can I be more consistent in this?

DO: Take time each day to read a bible story aloud to your children. Be sure to use a version or storybook bible that is age appropriate. Ask them questions that help them apply God's Word to their own lives.

Will You Pray for My Obedience?

REND

GONSIDER

ASK: What are some of the reasons why my children struggle with obedience? What needs to change?


DO: Think of someone you would like to show gratitude to today. Have your children write / make a thank you card for them.

PRAV




When you as parents are giving generously to the Lord, it's okay to tell your kids why you are doing it. The goal is not to boast about your kindness, but to invite your children to follow your example

GONSIDER

READ

PRAV



GONSIDER

Have you ever explained the Gospel to your children. The ABC of Salvation might be a great place to start: A: ADMIT that you are a sinner (Romans 3:23, 6:23) B: BELIEVE that Jesus is the Son of God, He died to take the punishment for our sins and rose again to make a way for us to have eternal life (John 3:16) C: CHOOSE to follow Jesus and give your life to Him (Romans 10:9-10)

Will You Pray for My Salvation?

Ask: How can I be intentional in helping my children take the next step in their relationship with Christ?



Do: After explaining the ABC's of Salvation, lead your children in the following prayer of salvation:

Dear Lord Jesus

I am sorry for all my sin. Please forgive me. I believe in You and that You died on the cross and then rose again for me. Please come into my heart and fill me with Your Holy Spirit. Today, I choose to be a Christian and follow You forever. Amen.
