About Us

The Trinity Christian Schools were established in 1992 as a vision of the Rector of the Church of the Most Holy Trinity, Archdeacon E. Etienne E. Bowleg, and Dr. Diane Major.

The Preschool offers K3 to K5. The Primary School classes start at Grade 1 through to Grade 6.



Our Philosophy & Goals K3-K5

We believe that children thrive in a loving, godly environment and aim to provide a safe, joyful learning environment in which a strong early learning foundation is built.

KINDERGARTEN (K3)

The K3 programme focuses on building students' love for learning and love for God. learn through pre-reading activities, development of letters and sounds knowledge, number and counting skills and more. Young learners engage in concrete discoveries about the world around them as they learn about health, manners and safety. K3 students receive Physical Education, Music, Computers and Swimming instruction in a highly-engaging and child-friendly environment.

KINDERGARTEN (K4)

At the K4 level, students begin to cement the preschool learning foundation through basic instruction in Phonemic Awareness, Phonics and High-Frequency Word and Reading fundamentals. As early writers, students develop gross and fine-motor skills through a variety of pre-writing activities. Bible, Social Studies, Health, Manners, Safety, and Fine Arts - all from a Christian perspective. The children also engage in Computer classes, Music, Physical Education and Swimming lessons.

KINDERGARTEN (K5)

K5 learners consolidate core Language and Number skills and strengthen early reading, writing and thinking skills through instruction in Phonics, Reading, Handwriting, Mathematics, and Bible. Science, Health, Social Studies, and Fine Arts. Students continue with Music, Physical Education, Computers, and Swimming classes, with an introduction to Spanish o.

Our Preschool Programme:

Our comprehensive curriculum is designed to build academic excellence and to promote the development of Christian principles and godly character.

Our Abeka Curriculum resources are Biblically based and are used throughout the school to nurture a firm spiritual and academic foundation for our young learners. Supplementary materials are also used to enhance and enrich the general curriculum. Students enjoy Art, Music and Physical Education (including Swimming).

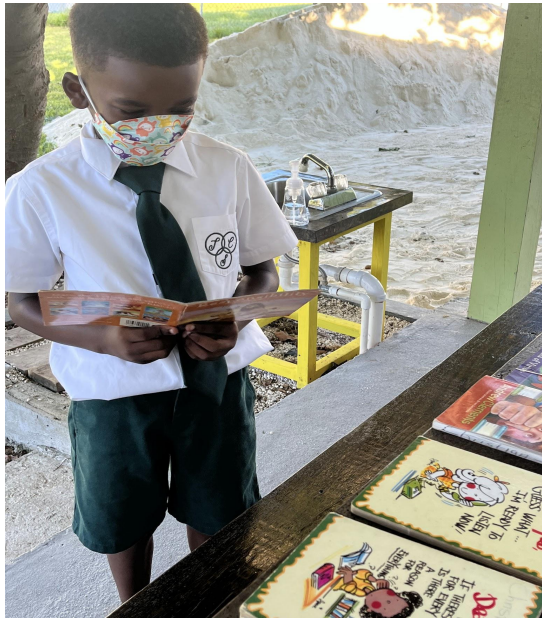

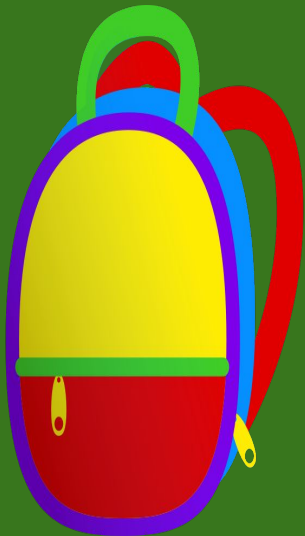




Home Reading Experiences
