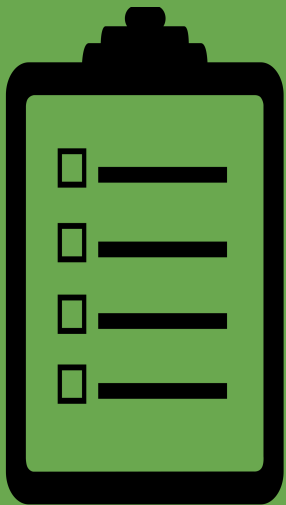


Reading to LEAD!
