James H. Walsh Deed To The Deacons of Salem Church

This Indenture made this the twentieth day January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty four between James H. Walsh of the first part and Beverly Willingham Caleb Willingham and Richard Appeling and John Thomas of the regular associated Baptist Church at Salem of the second part all of the County of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama. Witnesseth That the said party of the first part for and in Consideration of the sum of Forty Dollars to him in hand paid on and before the ensualing and delivery of these presents by the party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and Conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell and Convey unto the said party of the second part a tract or parcel of Land situate Lots Number One hundred and Twenty six and one hundred and twenty seven lying and being in the town of New Lexington also all that tract or parcel of Land lying adjoining and east of said Lots to the Line of the Lands belonging to W. D. Redden and Austin Woodward all in Section County line Township Section Range Eleven West in the Tuscaloosa Land District and State of Alabama the same being three acres more or less together with all and singular the Immovables and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and also all the Estate right title interest claim or demand whatsoever of them the said party of the first part either in Law or Equity or in and to the above bargained premises and every parcel and part thereof to have and hold to the said party of the second part or their successors in Office forever and the said party of the first part with hereby Warrant and forever defend the title of the above bargained premises to the said Beverly Willingham Caleb Willingham Richard Appeling and John Thomas or their successors in office free from the claim or claims of all and every other person or persons whatsoever as also the claims of the General Government In Testimony whereof the aforesaid party of the first part hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date of year above written James H.
