In light of recent leadership discussions regarding the size of our congregation versus our numerous ministry roles, Congregational Council is working on **a plan to reduce the number of roles and distribute some responsibilities differently**. This will likely need congregational approval, as these changes would require that we work outside of our bylaws. More information will be coming!

Financial Update: Offerings & other income through the end of November 2022 totaled \$126,035; expenses for the same time period totaled \$157,313, for a net shortfall of \$31,278. Additional funds of approximately \$33,000 are available to be used if needed (\$23,500 from 2020 & 2021 surpluses, and \$9,500 in Employee Retention Credits from the government from 2021). Next year's budget decisions will be impacted by our financial situation at the end of 2022. Thank you for your continued support of our church!
