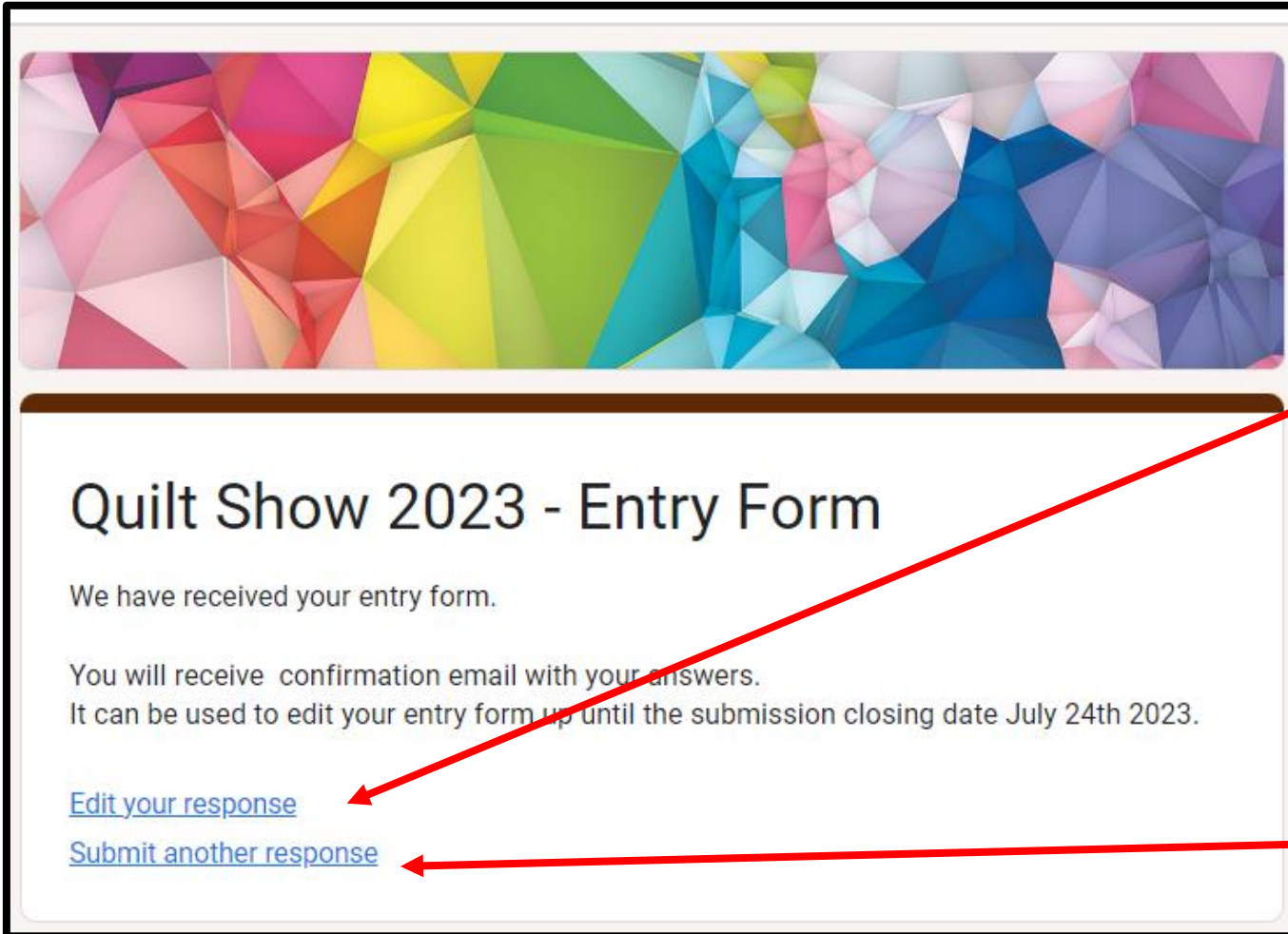
Open Confirmation email you receive on your phone.

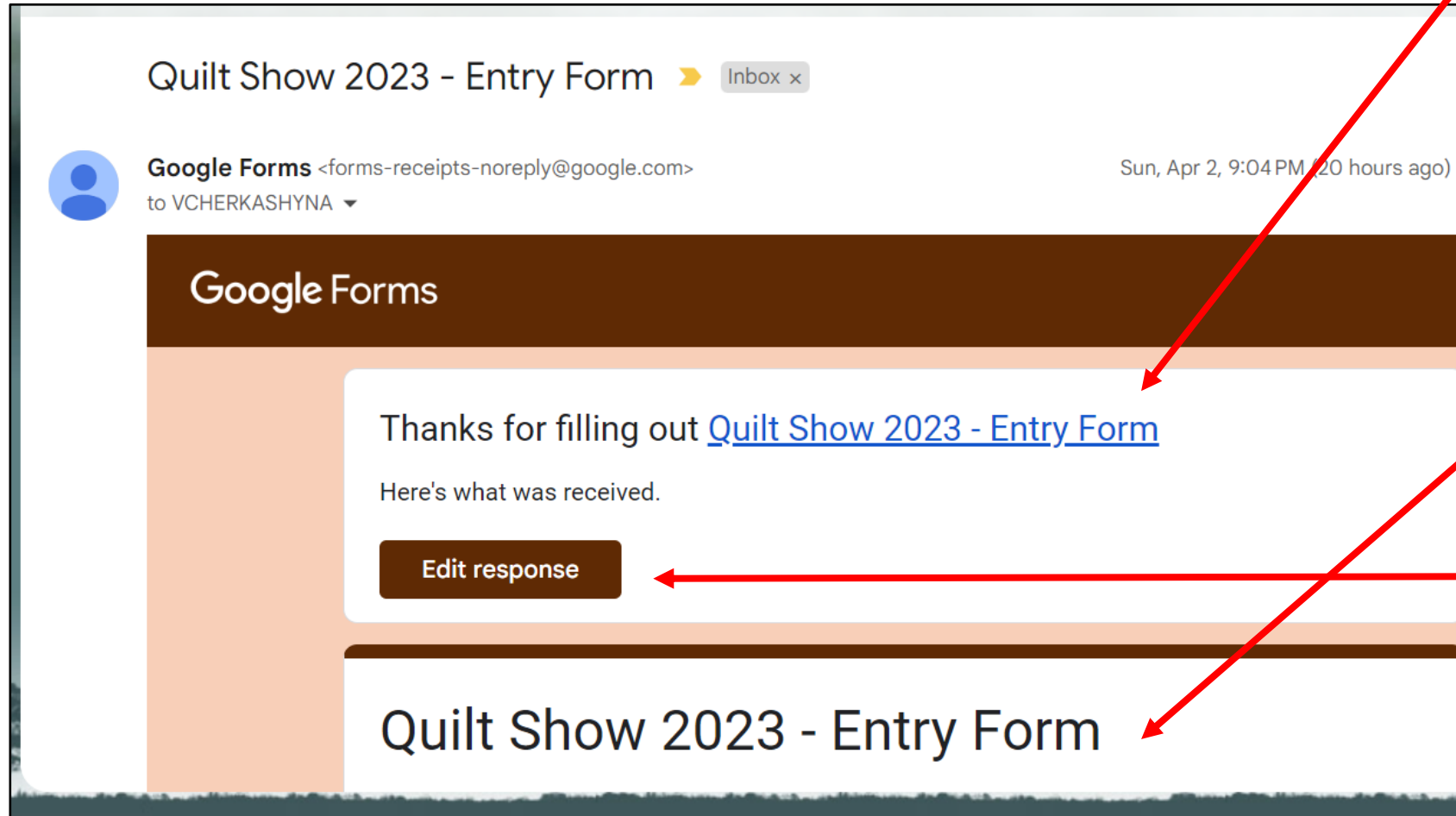
