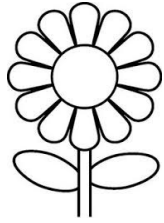

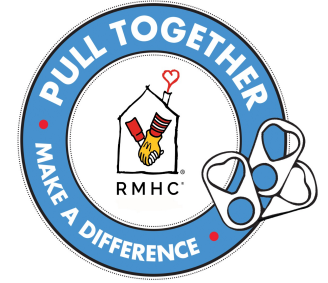

We have been praying for four year old Jackson Lawson, a student at Ben Hazel Primary School, who was recently diagnosed with a rare cancer. The following was posted on Facebook by Jackson’s mom, Reanna Lawson, on March 5:

“On February 23rd we got the worst news a parent could receive. Jackson has cancer. He has Rhabdomyosarcoma, which is a rare soft tissue sarcoma. It’s in his jaw. They have to treat it with chemo and radiation. He started chemotherapy last night and got his first round. He will have 40 weeks of chemo and some radiation. Then we’ll have a year of “maintenance” which will be a monthly chemo. He’s had tons of scans done and thank the Lord it’s only in his jaw!”
