Lil Drawdy, Lewis Ramsey, and Amelia Smith are currently serving. These three are not eligible to be nominated this year.



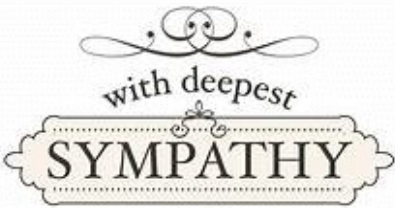
