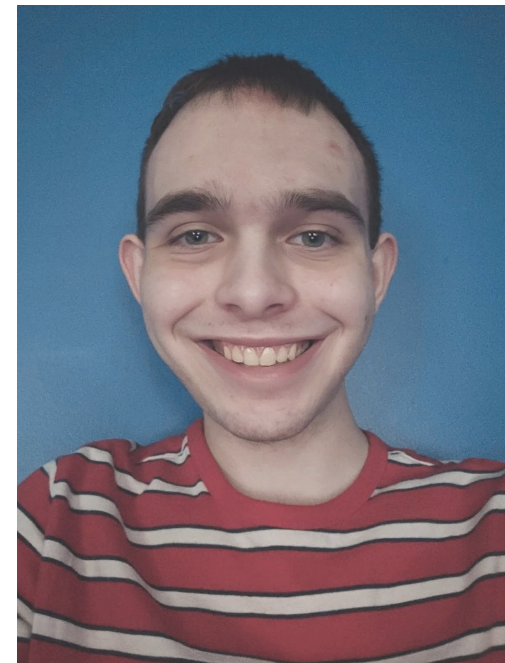

We will have a called church conference on Sunday, June 14, 2026, to present an amendment to the church’s By-Laws, as recommended by the By-Laws Ministry Team. We will discuss and vote on this amendment at the regularly scheduled church conference on Sunday, July 12, 2026. The By-Laws Ministry team is proposing the following change to the last sentence of Article VII., Section 3:

**Article VII. Deacons
Section 3. Qualifications**

The New Testament standards are found in Acts 6:3-6 and I Timothy 3:8-15. Deacons are expected to demonstrate exemplary Christian testimony both in private and public life, be committed supporters and promoters of the church faith, practice, programs and ministries. A deacon should be regular in attendance and faithful in financial stewardship. To be nominated to serve as a deacon one must be at least twenty-five years of age, must have been a Christian for at least five years and a continuous member of First Baptist Hampton for at least two years.

Proposed Amendment
