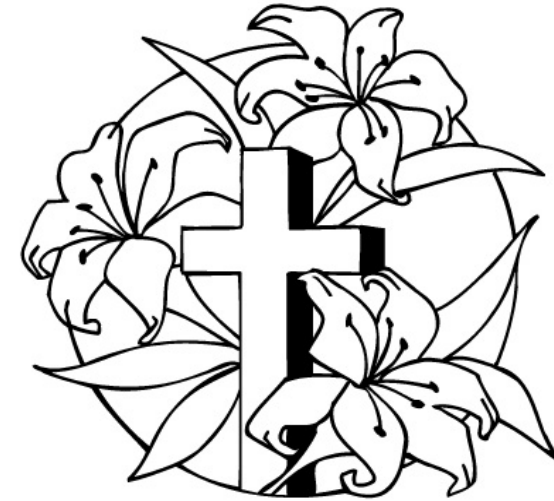

New Roof for the Church

Information regarding the funding of a new roof for our church was presented during a Special Called Church Conference on Sunday, March 8, 2026. The following proposal, presented by the Finance Ministry Team, was approved:

~set up an account to receive \$75,000 in gifts to cover the total cost of replacing the roof,

~use money from the Reserve Account and the Zeigler Account to pay for this project until funds are raised, and

~reimburse the Reserve and Zeigler Accounts once funds are raised/as funds are raised.

Southern Carolina Builders (Mikell Wood’s company) started the roofing job on March 23 and are moving right along.

Gifts are already coming in and, as of March 23, 2026, we are at \$20,515.

Prayer Walking is simply walking a route and praying for the people/households/things you see as you walk. This is a super easy ministry that everyone can participate in by doing the following:

~Choose a route card or cards (all routes are less than a mile). There are 6 prayer suggestions to help guide you on the back of each route card (24 different prayers in all),

~Take “Plan of Salvation” cards with you to leave at homes you pass

~Walk (or drive if you’re unable to walk) your chosen route, and pray for the households, businesses, and individuals you pass,

~Return route card(s) and complete the sign in sheet with information about your walk(s).

If you choose to walk an area not included in on the cards, please include the distance you prayer walked. We need lots of people walking and praying for our community.
