CONFERENCE SPEAKERS





On Wednesday evening, Congressman **Chip Roy** (TX-21) opened the conference with an inspiring reflection on D-Day. He spoke on the courage of the young soldiers who made the ultimate sacrifice to preserve freedom for future generations.

The next morning, Dr. **Burt Folsom**, YAF's longest-serving faculty member, gave an energetic history lesson on how the United States ascended to global power.



He was followed by activist and detransitioner **Chloe Cole**. Cole is a survivor of radical gender ideology. She powerfully stated, "[Leftists] view people like me as an existential threat. My story challenges the narrative they cling to so rabidly...Shining light on the flaws of their ideology feels like an attack on their very souls."











Thursday afternoon, students discovered why President Reagan named his beloved ranch "Rancho del Cielo" and famously remarked, "We relax at the ranch, which if not Heaven itself, probably has the same ZIP code."

They toured his Ranch home, tack barn, and Secret Service Command Post and cruised through his trails in open-air Jeeps.









Students were greeted in the Hay Barn by *Reagan* film producer **Mark Joseph**. In this special session, Joseph gave students an exclusive look at the movie's production.







Later that evening, YAF Chief
Communications Officer **Spencer Brown**interviewed **Shavit Rootman**, a former
Duvdevan soldier in the Israel Defense
Forces. Rootman emphasized how JudeoChristian values serve as the foundation of
the U.S.-Israel alliance.

Dr. Folsom then returned to the stage to deliver a lesson on how freedom and entrepreneurship define America as the land of opportunity and prosperity.

On Friday morning, Governor **Scott Walker** encouraged students to stand firm for freedom and truth. He told them, "As conservatives, we're the ones who have a united message. We believe in freedom and opportunity for everyone. The Left wants to divide us. We believe that anyone in America has the right to pursue the American Dream."





Author and commentator **Josh Hammer** delivered a crash course on defending Western civilization and signed copies of his latest book, *Israel and Civilization: The Fate of the Jewish Nation and the Destiny of the West.*

To wrap up the afternoon, Congressman **Tom McClintock** discussed the ongoing struggle to defend freedom against tyranny.






WENDY P. MCCAW REAGAN RANCH ROUNDTABLE

Lt. Col. West then delivered an incredibly inspiring message to an audience of more than 400 students, supporters, and friends at the Wendy P. McCaw Roundtable. His remarks were a standout highlight of the program! He discussed the historic 1775 Battles of Lexington and Concord to emphasize the significance of fighting for freedom and upholding the Constitution today. West stated, "We must continue to tell these stories. If we don't do it, someone will tell a different story. We must continue to pass on understanding what living in this Constitutional Republic means because we have that responsibility."



"The task and purpose that we have is to pass a torch...We have to inspire the next generation of young men and young women. And I see that happening every time I come to a YAF event. I see that you're committed to these young people...because life is not about what we achieve ourselves. Life is about the legacy we leave to subsequent generations."







The final day of the conference focused on significant policy issues. **Daniel Turner**, founder of Power the Future, highlighted the dangers of radical environmentalism.

Daniel Di Martino, founder of the Dissident Project, shared how socialism devastated his home country of Venezuela.

Dr. **AWR Hawkins**, *Breitbart* Second Amendment columnist, presented a compelling case for gun rights, stating, "The more limited the government is, the more free the people are."

In the afternoon, **Anna Strasburg**, pro-life activist and founder of If Life, passionately defended the unborn.

To wrap up the programming, YAF Program Officer **Charlie Jones** offered guidance on starting and leading an effective YAF chapter on campus.
