

## **Discussion Books** The Boo Boo Kitty Series

Right now, two of the six Boo Boo Kitty books are available for sale at Dorrance Publishing and at other national retail outlets. They are *Meet Boo Boo Kitty!* and *The Misadventures of Boo Boo Kitty!* The third book — *Boo Boo Kitty Goes to the Mountains* — will be out in mid-2024.

The six books in the Boo Boo Kitty series are intended to be **discussion books**, where kids or adults read the books together and discuss all sorts of important topics like faith, family values, and feelings, to name a few.

The entire book can be read in a few minutes and the discussions can occur after that, or the discussions can occur after each page ... it's your choice.


These discussions can take place in the family room at home, in the classroom at school, or in a small group setting at church.

- FRONT COVER PAGE: What do you see on the cover of the book? When you're with your/ our family, are you mostly happy or sad, and why? What makes you happy? What makes you sad?
- **PAGE 1 OF THE STORY:** Do you have a favorite stuffed animal? Can it talk? How big and special is the world? (If you are with kids who are fascinated by the universe, you can talk about it.)
- PAGES 2 & 3: Look at Boo Boa's face ... what is he thinking or feeling?
- PAGES 4 & 5: Boo Boo was made during a bad summer storm ... do thunder storms bother you? What else scares you? Anything?
- PAGES 6 & 7: Boo Boo was made by NeeNee, but do you have any questions about how you came to be?
- **PAGES 8 & 9:** Look at Boo Boo's face ... what do you see? Why was he scared? What didn't Boo Boo understand?
- PAGES 10 & 11: Here Boo Boo learned about NeeNee's family ... what did you find out recently about your family?
- **PAGES 12 & 13:** What is a home for people? What is the home for birds? For rabbits? For bees? For cows? For squirrels?
- PAGES 14 & 15: Do you understand the word curious? Is it good to be curious ... to want to learn and know things?
- PAGES 16 & 17: What does your home look like? Why is it special to you?
- PAGES 18 & 19: Like Boo Boo, what did you see recently that you didn't understand?
- PAGES 20 & 21: What are your favorite games to play with family members or friends? Why are those games fun to you?
- PAGES 22 & 23: Who are the people in your life who you love and why? What does love mean to you? Why is love so important in our lives?
- **PAGES 24 & 25:** Boo Boo is showing his love for Macey by protecting her while she sleeps. Who protects you and keeps you safe? What is kindness to you and why is it so important for us to be kind to others?
- **PAGES 26 & 27:** What does your home look like? (Draw a picture of it and your family and talk about how cool it is to be in a family.)
- PAGE 28: If the Christian faith is important to you or you want to know more about Jesus, start reading small passages together as a family from The Bible and talk about what God is saying and doing. This can lead to many wonderful discussions and will increase the joy in your life!
