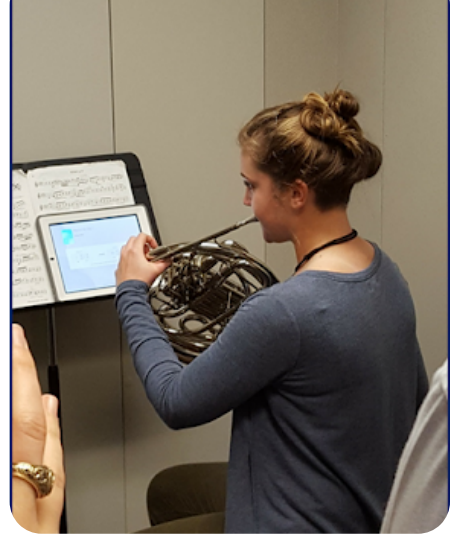

Grant Tips



Coaching Session

Attend a Grant Coaching Session! Sessions are typically offered during GISD GROW to give feedback on your ideas and discuss technology and/or curriculum needs.



Application Focus

Ensure that your application highlights how your proposal is innovative.



Apply Appropriately

Consider whether your proposal is appropriate for Fall (\$500 Individual award) or Spring (\$5000 Collaborative award).



During/After School Activity

Priority is given to proposals for innovative teaching and learning occurring during the school day. If your application is primarily for an after-school activity, consider how the proposal could be incorporated into day learning.



Know Your Audience

Remember that grant application readers are not GISD employees. Be sure your proposal includes detailed explanations that can be understood. Avoid educational jargon or abbreviations.
