# **Coaching Session**

Attend a Grant Coaching Session! Sessions are typically offered during the Spring to give feedback on your ideas and discuss technology and/or curriculum needs.



## **Application Focus**

Ensure that your application highlights how your proposal is innovative.



## **Apply Appropriately**

Consider whether your proposal is appropriate for Fall (\$500 Individual award) or Spring (\$5000 Collaborative award).



# **During/After School Activity**

Priority is given to proposals for innovative teaching and learning occurring during the school day. If your application is primarily for an after-school activity, consider how the proposal could be incorporated into day learning.



### **Know Your Audience**

Remember that grant application readers are not GISD employees. Be sure your proposal includes detailed explanations that can be understood. Avoid educational jargon or abbreviations.
