Heat B - 45 mins + 1 lap – (Women's Open, Women's F2, 75 MPH, Unlimited, Double Up)
Heat A - 60 mins + 1 lap – (Men's Open, Men's F2, Unlimited, Double Up)

OTHER THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW and REMINDERS

1. **All participants** MUST be a member of USAWS and sign the race day release prior to the close of registration. Skiers under age 18 need to have a parent or legal guardian sign on their behalf.
2. **All participants** MUST pass breathalyzer testing prior to participation. NWSRA maintains a 0 tolerance policy for participants. All drivers and observers, in addition to skiers in the first set of races must pass during the registration period (prior to 8:30am) each day. Skiers in the later set of races will have an additional opportunity during the lunch break. These will be the only 2 opportunities.
3. **All boats** must pass Safety / Boat Inspection prior to participation if not previously inspected in 2025.
4. Saturday races will be run on a circle / sprint race course approximately 2 miles in length.
5. Pole positions will be drawn for the Saturday sprint races in March and and reversed for the same Saturday classes at the May race. Heat races and finals or starting flights MAY be run as necessary depending on entries (including boat / observer conflicts) and course restrictions.
6. Must be a minimum of 3 skier teams in the race or the class will be combined with another class.
