Subject: Assistant Coaches for 2022 Canada Summer Games

Swimming Newfoundland and Labrador is seeking Assistant Coaches for the 2022 Canada Games. Applicants must be available to coach the Canada Games Team at all training events leading up to the Canada Games, including but not limited to training March 28-31, June 27-28, July 11-August 4 and work with the Head Coach and Team Manager.

Criteria:

- Assistant coaches must be Age Group Coach certified. Assistant Coaches must be certified not later than 90 days before the opening of the Games (May 1, 2022).
- Minimum of three (3) years coaching swimmers that are at the Newfoundland "Provincial" level.

Overview:

- Assist the Head Coach in the performance of their duties, as assigned by the Head Coach.
- Instill the spirit of the Canada Games in each athlete.
- Know, understand, and adhere to all policies, roles and responsibilities for the position as detailed in the <u>Team Newfoundland and Labrador</u> <u>Canada Games Policies and Procedures Manual.</u>

- Ensure that all sport team members know, understand, and adhere to the Team Newfoundland and Labrador's <u>Code of Conduct</u> and <u>Dress Code</u>.
- Abide by and enforce all rules established by the sport team, the provincial sport organization, Team Newfoundland and Labrador, the Canada Games Council, and the host Society.
- Attend all required meetings and official functions before during and after the Games.
- Keep parents/guardians and athletes fully informed on all matters relating to the Canada Games.

Prior to the Games:

- Achieve NCCP Age Group Coach certified status by the required deadline.
- Assist the Head Coach to develop, and present to the PSO for approval, a plan for the training of the team.
- Assist the Head Coach to prepare the athletes to achieve the best possible competitive results, in a fair and sportsmanlike manner.
- Sign the Team Newfoundland and Labrador Member Agreement.
- Maintain NCCP code of ethics.
- Maintain appropriate records.
- Promote the sport of swimming.

During the Games:

- Supervise athletes and assume responsibility for their conduct, before during and immediately after the Games, including during travel to and from the Games.
- Report Code of Conduct violations to the Head Coach and participate in the disciplinary process as outlined in the <u>Team Newfoundland and</u> <u>Labrador Canada Games Policies and Procedures Manual.</u>
- Reside in the Athletes' Village during the Canada Games.
- Provide competition results when requested by mission staff.
