Swimming Newfoundland Labrador (SNL) SENIOR Development Team Selection Criteria for May Travel Meet

The Provincial Team will attend the Neptune Invitational May 19,20,21 in Montreal at the Olympic Park Sports Centre. [Recreational swimming - Parc Olympique : Parc Olympique](#) This is a great meet with finals for 13 and over swimmers which will provide a great racing opportunity for all swimmers. Travel will take place from St. John's, participants will be responsible for travel to the metro area prior to departure. The expected cost is \$1000 for each athlete.

Section A-Eligibility

To qualify for the 2023 Senior Development Team, meet swimmers must be residents of Newfoundland and Labrador and be registered members in good standing with Swimming Newfoundland and Labrador.

Senior team members can include any registered year-round SNL swimmer. Swimmers who are eligible for the junior team can be called up to the senior team.

Travel Meet Team: The full team will be composed of 8 junior males 8 junior females and 8 senior males 8 senior females.

Senior Travel Team Positions

A maximum of 8 males and 8 females will be selected to the team.

1. Swimmers will be selected off combined FINA points in three events. Swimmers can use either long course or short course events but cannot use the same event twice.
2. In the event of a tie the swimmer with the highest FINA points in a fourth event will be selected.

Due to the unavailability of the Swim Canada Rankings the process for selection will be defined in the middle of March, swimmers who have submitted a declaration will be contacted with those details. Swimmers will be contacted and invited to join the teams by March 30, 2023. Swimmers must accept or decline by April 3, 2023

Coach Selection:

- Coaches must hold a minimum of level 2 certification.
- One coach will be selected to travel as the Senior Team Assistant Coach with the Provincial Coach. The club with the most senior swimmers selected will be asked to nominate a coach for selection.
