## **Coach Eligibility Requirements:**

- Member in good-standing with their respective Swimming NL, CSCTA, and Swimming Canada
- NCCP Level 2 Certified or equivalent
- Consistently demonstrated the following key competencies and skills: Technical, Leadership, Professionalism, Communication, Ethics
- Previous Provincial Team Experience

Each participating Atlantic Team will have the opportunity to appoint Coaches based on the following ratio:

One or more swimmer named to Team Atlantic = One Coach

Six or more swimmers named to Team Atlantic = Two Coaches

Twelve or more swimmers named to Team Atlantic = Three Coaches

Coach appointments to be determined by the number of swimmers named to the Team (provided the above Eligibility requirements are met). Should there be a tie, the highest ranked swimmer (under priority order) will be considered the tie-break.

Coaches will be required to complete and agree to adhere to the Swimming NL Code of Conduct & Staff Agreement as a condition of their acceptance to the team.

Coaches are required to complete Swimming Canada's Respect in Sport for Activity Leader program.
