Wanted: Custodial Contract Cleaner

Branch 256 Stony Plain of the Royal Canadian Legion is seeking a contract custodian to perform weekly and monthly cleaning at the branch.

Reporting to the President and/or designate, the duties would be as follows:

Weekly

Hall: Floors washed, walls spot-washed as needed, chairs and tables washed as needed, washrooms cleaned and stocked.

Kitchen: Floors washed, cupboard fronts washed, counters/appliances wiped down, and sanitized

Foyer: Doors and windows cleaned, floors washed

Lounge: Floors washed, chairs/tables/counters wiped down/pictures/plaques dusted, as needed, walls spot-washed as needed, washrooms cleaned and stocked

Bar: Wash floor in bar serving area, counter and cooler doors to be cleaned, for weeks opening, walls spot-washed

Monthly

Hall: Pictures dusted, tables washed with bleach water, clean mirrors over dart boards

The custodian is not responsible for repairs or building maintenance, or cleaning the inside of the fridges, freezers or stove.

Standard of cleanliness will be directed by employer before or at start of agreement

The custodian is required to have proof of industry standard qualifications ie. WIMIS along with WCB and Third-Party Liability Insurance.
