

On February 6, 1946, the HMS Mauretania departed Liverpool with 943 war brides and children on board, beginning a journey that would reshape thousands of Canadian families.

From 1939 to 1945, half a million Canadian soldiers served in Britain. During that time, as many as one in 10 married local women, leading to a wave of European brides immigrating to Canada in 1946.

When the Mauretania arrived at Pier 21 in Halifax on February 9, 1946, it marked a defining moment in this movement.

These women, many of whom had left their home for the first time, showed remarkable courage as they stepped into an uncertain future in a new country.

80 years later, we honour the strength and resilience of the war brides who crossed an ocean for love, hope, and new beginnings, and whose stories remain an important part of Canada's postwar history.


