Today, we honour the extraordinary bravery and sacrifice of the Canadian Corps during the Battle of Passchendaele, one of the most grueling and tragic struggles of the First World War.

In the shattered fields of Flanders, amid relentless rain, deep mud, and unthinkable conditions, Canadian soldiers were called upon to do the impossible. Over the course of just over two weeks in October and November 1917, they fought with determination and resilience. In the end, they captured the ruined Belgian village of Passchendaele and the ridge beyond, securing a hard-won victory.

But that battlefield success came at a terrible cost with more than 4,000 Canadians killed and nearly 12,000 wounded.

Passchendaele became a symbol, not just of the horrors of war, but of the courage, endurance and sacrifice that helped shape Canada's national identity. It is a reminder of the price of peace and the strength of those who serve.

We remember them. We honour them. We will not forget.
