Act now: Deadline for Disability Pensions Class Action Settlement is March 19, 2025

Veterans Affairs Canada settled a class action lawsuit relating to the miscalculation of disability pension benefits payable between 2003 and 2023 to disabled Canadian Armed Forces and RCMP veterans and their survivors.

- Living veterans will receive their settlement payments automatically; no action is required.
- Estates of deceased veterans, family members or survivors of veterans may be eligible to claim payments of about \$2,500 with some exceeding \$10,000 and even \$35,000.

The entire claims process is being administered by KPMG, who have created a website where claims can be made here. KPMG have also established a toll-free call center to answer questions (1-833-839-0648).

The deadline to make a claim is on March 19, 2025.
