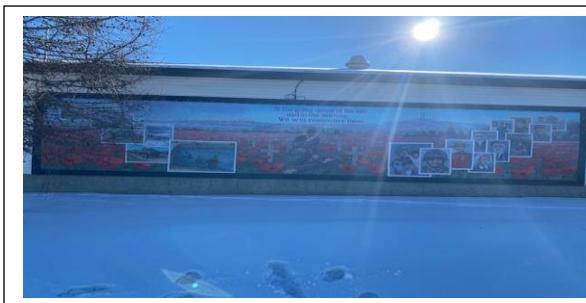

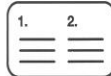

On a personal note, I would like to thank the members of the Executive for all their help in my first couple of months as President and looking forward to working together over the next year.

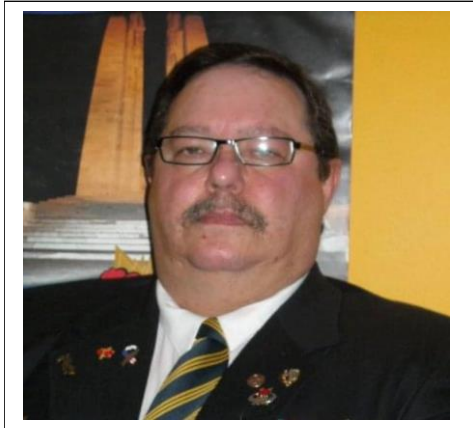
