It was 105 years ago today that the Canadian soldier who wrote this famous poem died from pneumonia and meningitis.

Lieutenant-Colonel John McCrae, a doctor and teacher, served in both the South African War and First World War.

He rose to prominence after his poem was first published in England's Punch magazine and it came to symbolize the sacrifices of those fighting in the First World War.
