#### Support for Veterans and Family's

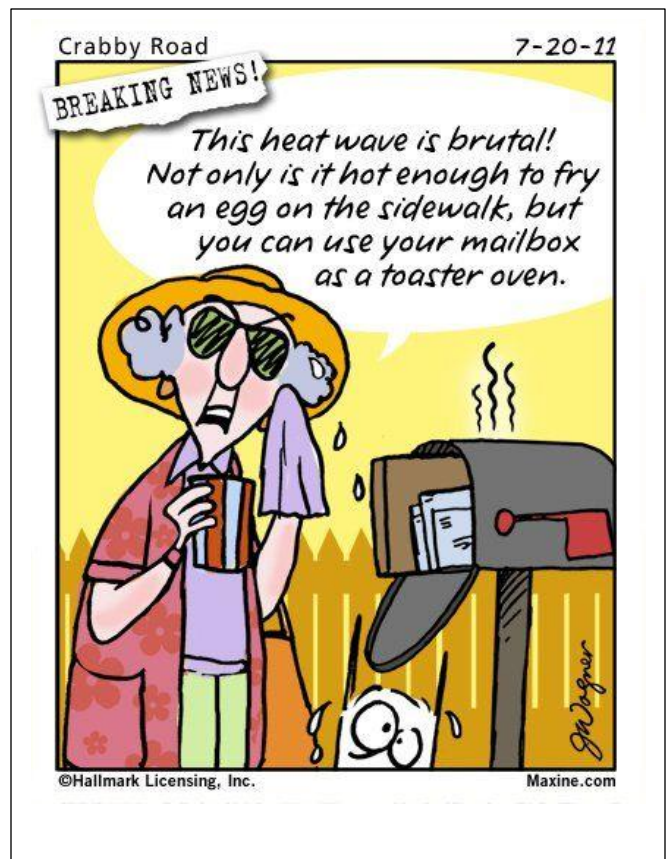
