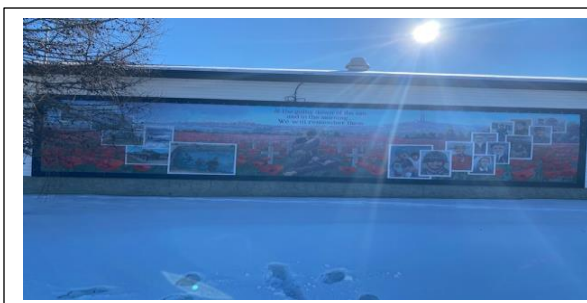

End of the mission in Afghanistan

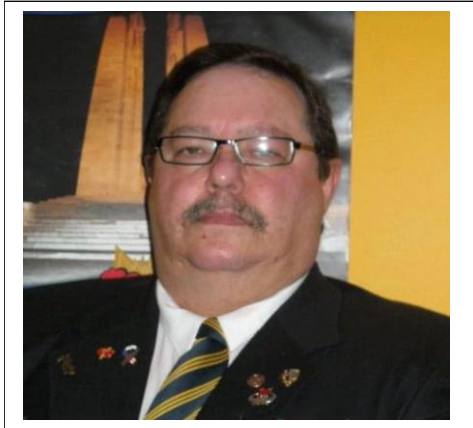


Eight years ago on March 12, the last Canadian troops came home from Afghanistan.
