This May 1st is the Battle of Atlantic Sunday, which commemorates the longest continuous military campaign of the Second World War.

This photograph shows the German submarine U-210, caught on the surface, maneuvering to escape the Canadian destroyer Assiniboine in the thick fog. Canadian sailors rarely saw the elusive submarines that stalked the convoys. Catching a surfaced U-Boat that had not already been disabled by depth charges was rarer still. This photograph shows the close proximity Assiniboine had to keep to prevent the U-Boat from escaping in the fog.
