- Ravens are the largest of the songbirds.
- They mimic calls of other bird species and also human speech.
- They are extremely smart and rate up there with dolphins & amp; chimpanzees.
- They love to play.
- They use "hand gestures" and very sophisticated non-vocal signals.
- They show empathy for each other.
- ② Young ravens roam around in "Teen-age Groups" causing mischief.
- They are extremely adaptable to different environments.
- Their normal lifespan is 13 years in the wild: in captivity they have been

know to live to 59 years.

- The raven is an acrobatic flyer & Deen observed flying upside-down.
- ② A group of ravens is known as a "bazaar", a "constable", or a "rant".
- ② Ravens differ from crows as their size is bigger; they have a larger bill,
- different tail shape, different wing make-up, and a different flight pattern.
- ② Ravens are capable of saving items of value that are later used as tools or
- as goods for barter, a behavior that strongly suggests the ability to plan

for a future when these items may be needed.




