Hi Everyone! Welcome to the first monthly addition of Be Fraud Aware for Stony Plain Legion Members!

Every month I will highlight a recent scam that is circulating and catching many people off guard or provide some suggestions for safe computing and online privacy. As always if you are looking for more information about scams and frauds affecting Canadians you can refer to the Candian Anti-Fraud Centre: Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre (antifraudcentre-centreantifraude.ca)

Recent scam currently targeting Canadians and specifically Canadian Seniors:

Card Pick-up Scam

A person will receive a phone call from some impersonating a bank employee. These fraudsters are usually able to provide a few pieces of personal information that they have obtained like name and address in order to gain the persons trust. They may even state things like "your card starting with 45**"

The fraudster will then continue to create an urgent scenario where you will feel it necessary to act. They will state that they have identified fraudulent activity on your account and that they need to cancel your card in order to protect you from loss. You are then instructed to put your card in an envelope with your PIN and to hand it over to the courier service that they are sending to pick-it up and bring it to head office for further investigation.

Typically the person picking up the card is an "associate" of the fraudster. Once you hand over this envelope, they have full access to your funds and before you know it, your bank account is empty!!

Remember, if you provide your PIN to a third party, your bank may not cover the unauthorized withdrawals from your account! Never - ever share your PIN or online banking password with anyone! Also remember, your bank will never call you or text you to alert you of a potential fraud on your account. They will always make you call them! And always, if you are calling you bank, make sure you call using the number on the back of your bank card or credit card and never a number that was provided by someone else!
