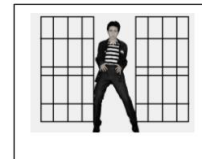

The first major commemoration will be the 65th Anniversary of the Korean War, and the Battle of Kapyong held in the lounge on 21 April at 1 Dam. Ceremony planned for an hour with a lunch and bar opening at 11 am.

The ceremony is open to the public, and at the next PPCLI Association meeting at the end of this month, I will be giving a special invitation to the members of the Association that fought in Korea, and the Korean Veterans Association to be our Guests of Honor.

We plan to have a simple, yet informative tribute to both the war and the battle. A speech will be given about the war, a speech from Cde Rob Mitchell whose father fought and was decorated for his actions at the Battle of Kapyong, and if willing, any member of the KV A to talk about their personal experiences during the war. As well there will be a display showcasing Canada's contributions to the war from all three elements, and a display showcasing the battle.
