

A Quilt of Valour is a hug from a grateful nation and a tribute to an Canadian Armed Forces member, past or present. I've heard of a few veterans declining a Quilt of Valour. Some feel they don't deserve one, or it should go to other veterans in need. Some veterans decline quilts because they feel they didn't do anything valorous while in The CAF.

We'd like to clarify things up. You are eligible for a quilt of valour if you meet the QOVC eligibility, Canadian Armed Forces members (veterans and serving members), regular or reserve force, must meet one of the following conditions:

- 1) Have served in a combat or peacekeeping mission including theatres of war. OR
- 2) Have become ill or injured as a result of their service to Canada, at home or abroad. Only veterans who have been Honourably Discharged are eligible to receive a Quilt of Valour. Although most of us will never know the soldier who will receive our quilt, imagine what it would be like for you if you did know the soldier. What if that soldier was your spouse, your brother/sister, your friend or your child?

A Quilt of Valour serves a special purpose and quality construction is important. Quilt standards must reflect the level of gratitude that we want to demonstrate to the recipient. Quilts of Valour can be made by individuals, social groups or quilting bees.
