In order to make a claim for a monetary award, and/or to request a personalized letter of apology from the Chief of the Defence Staff, and/or to participate in restorative engagement processes, you will need to submit an Individual Claim Form to the Claims Administrator. The claims period will open after April 10, 2025, but may be delayed for certain reasons.
