

Legion services for Veterans and their families

The Legion provides a range of services and supports for Veterans, their families and dependents. In addition to directly assisting Veterans and their families with the disability claims process through Veterans Affairs. Canada (VAC), the Legion offers a variety of programs, resources and referrals to support Veteran health, transition to civilian file, financial assistance and well-being.

At the local Legion Branch, a Veteran or their family can:
meet with a volunteer Legion Service Officer to help identify unmet health or support needs and review possible benefits through VAC, as well as other supports available
get assistance with completing the Legion Claims Form and receive a referral to Legion Command Service Officers for individual assistance
request benevolent financial assistance through the Poppy Fund
request visits to Veterans in refirement and long-term care facilities
access Veteran support and care programs as offered through the Branch
