MEDICAL SOCIAL WORKERS

The Alameda County Juvenile Justice Center (JJC) program seeks creative and dedicated social workers to deliver services to clients and communities effectively.

- The JJC MSW I/II is responsible for coordinating with Probation, Behavioral Health, and school district staff to ensure that the appropriate community and health resources are given to incarcerated youth aged 12-18 upon release.
- Per the 2003 Prison Rape Elimination Act ("PREA"), employees assigned at the JJC will be required to undergo additional background screenings that include:
 - Child Abuse Registry check
 - Criminal Justice Information System check
 - Attestation that the employee has not engaged in sexual misconduct
 - Subsequent records and child abuse checks will be conducted every 3 years
 - Initial PREA training and refresher training every 3 years
