Suggested roles and responsibilities of the **Buddy** to include but not limited to the following:

- Review their individual vehicle insurance policy to understand coverage for riders
- Extending an offer of a ride for a pared member to, during, and or from a club event

- Assistance in loading and unloading gear from vehicles to and from vehicles, room/cabin, fishing spots and or docks.
- Assist in cleaning and packaging fish for transport using assigned member's tools and supplies

Suggested roles and responsibilities of the **Member Special Assistance** to include but not limited to the following:

- Create list of who needs assistance
- Create list of who will be a Buddy
- Identify needs of each attendee
- Match each person based on the event

Suggested roles and responsibilities of the **Member** to include but not limited to the following:

- Review their individual vehicle insurance policy to understand coverage for additional drivers of their vehicle

- Establish an agreed upon communication between themselves and their Buddy for the duration of the club event
- If there is a change in any of the arrangements between Buddy and Member, the member will immediately let a MSA Committee member know of the situation for a resolution
