Dress code is enforced at Maraya Performing Arts with safety and functionality in mind. Proper attire is vital in making sure the Teaching Artists can see and correct alignment to help further support student's growth in their technique. We strive to be inclusive and understanding to all students that come through our doors. If for any reason you find yourself uncomfortable with any parts of the dress code, please talk to the front desk team. For all classes, these are things to keep in mind:

- Hair must be secured and pulled away from the face.
- For children 8 years and older, Boys must wear an Athletic Dance Belt and Girls must wear an Athletic Sports Bra.
- Jewelry is not allowed as it is a hazard and a distraction.
- Dance shoes are only to be worn inside the studio. No street shoes on the dance floor, unless they are used for a specific style of dance. There are cubbies available to store shoes and other personal belongings.

*****PLEASE DO NOT WEAR YOUR DANCE SHOES OUTSIDE!**

**WEAR SLIDES, CROCS or SLIP ON SHOES and then change into and out of
your dance shoes.*****

- Maraya t-shirts, long sleeves, and sweatshirts and tote bags are available for purchase in our studio only.
- ACRO & PRE-ACRO: Students should wear all black attire. Tops: a Black biketard, Black Leotard or well fitted Shirt. Bottoms: black biker shorts or black leggings. Practicing acro barefoot is preferred; however, jazz shoes are acceptable.
- YOUTH BALLET TECHNIQUE: For ballet classes (except teen/adult ballet), leotard and tights must be worn along with ballet slippers. Tights should be worn under the student's leotard. Ballet shoes are REQUIRED. Students may wear ballet skirts over leotards. Their clothing should not be so baggy that alignment can't be seen by the Teaching Artist. All ballet students must wear leather "No-Tie Student" ballet shoes in Classic Pink. Hair must be pulled back and away from the face.

- MINI BALLET: Students in our 1A classes will be wearing our Tank Bow Dress in Princess Pink.
- JUNIORS BALLET: Students in our 1A classes will be wearing leotards in Mulberry, classic pink tights, and pink ballet shoes. All items can be purchased on our online store.
- JUNIORS 1B * TWEENS/TEENS BALLET: Students in our 1B or level 2 classes will be wearing leotards in Black with Black Leggings. Ballet shoes are preferred, but we will also accept jazz shoes.
- JAZZ: All black attire – Students should wear tan or black jazz shoes, fitted black leggings and black leotard and/or Maraya T-Shirts.
- MUSICAL THEATRE INTRO OR MUSICAL THEATRE PERFORMANCE: All black attire – Students should wear tan or black jazz shoes, fitted black leggings and black Maraya T-Shirts. Joggers and leggings are acceptable.
 - ALL STUDENTS MUST wear a Maraya T-shirt, plain black leggings and black jazz shoes.
- TAP FUNDAMENTALS: Students may wear their black Maraya t-shirts, long-sleeve, or leotard. No jeans or denim. Tap shoes are required.
- VOCAL TECHNIQUE/MUSIC THEORY: Students must wear Maraya Black T-shirts and black bottoms like leggings, joggers, or sweats. Black Jazz Shoes Required. <https://www.shopnimbley.com/maraya>

ADULT DANCE CLASSES:

- ADULT CONTEMPORARY TECHNIQUE: Students should wear well-fitted clothing. Since this class involves a lot of floorwork, students are advised to wear clothes that cover their arms and legs. Students can be barefoot or wear socks. Please be mindful of hair and body moisturizers that may transfer onto the floor and make the area slippery.
- ADULT DANCE FITNESS: tank top. Please wear clean sneakers that are not in regular use like gym shoes. You need separate dedicated shoes to wear on our professional dance floor. Please NO dirty street shoes or Crocs on the dance floor please. Please change in and out of your shoes. Fuegos or Capezio dance sneakers are ideal athletic dance shoes.

PRE-SCHOOL CLASSES:

- ZUMBINI: Students should wear comfortable attire to move around in. No dresses please! Samples of attire include: sweats, leggings, shorts, a t-shirt or tank top and grippy socks. Adults should also dress the same. Please note that we do not allow outside street shoes on our dance floor, so please wear socks or a different pair of shoes you can change in and out of for class. Grippy socks are required for all babies.
- PRE-ACRO DANCE: Students should wear all black attire. Tops: a Black biketard, Black Leotard or well fitted Shirt. Bottoms: black biker shorts or black leggings. Practicing acro barefoot is preferred; however, jazz shoes are acceptable.
- BABY BROADWAY BOUND: All black attire – Students should wear black jazz shoes, fitted black leggings/joggers/sweats and a black Maraya T-Shirts. No dresses please! Maraya shirts are available for sale at the front desk only and we can help you find the appropriate size to order online. Once you are fitted, you can purchase your Jazz shoes here: shopnimble.com/maraya
 - ALL BABY BROADWAY BOUND STUDENTS (*adults and babies*) *must* wear a Maraya T-shirt, plain black leggings and black jazz shoes.
