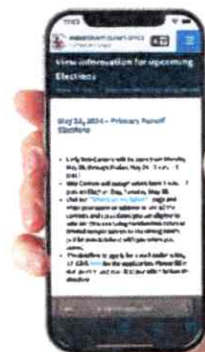

Voters will select the President of the United States, and other federal, state, and local positions.

MAKE A PLAN TO VOTE

Requirements:

- 65 years of age or older on Election Day.
- Voter is sick or disabled.
- Expecting to give birth within three weeks before or after Election Day.
- Absent from the county of registration during the Early Voting period and on Election Day.
- Confined in jail, but otherwise eligible to vote.

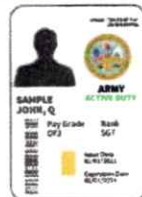
