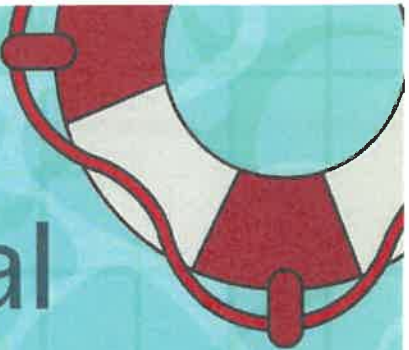

North Park Drive Overpass Project

The contractor has resumed installing the 6' x 8' box culverts down the center of North Park Drive. Entergy is slowly moving the utility poles along North Park Drive out of the project right of way. The extra northbound turn lanes at Hwy 59 are being used relieving some of the congestion at that intersection. The Russell Palmer crossover closure will take longer than expected.

City of Houston

City of Houston is sponsoring a BOPA (Batteries, Oil, Paint [latex], Anti-freeze) event on April 27 at the Kingwood Metro Park and Ride, from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. This event will also include a prescription drug take back event.

Humble ISD

Humble ISD is currently conducting State required testing. To minimize disruption to the students, HISD has slow down grounds maintenance. The HISD Fine Arts Festival will be held on May 4 on the Lone Star-Kingwood campus. The Chicago Musical will be presented on May 8 to 11 on the Kingwood High School campus. The construction of a new school to replace Foster Elementary School will start in August of this year. The students will be going to other elementary schools in Kingwood during the construction.

Kingwood Library

The Institute of Museum and Library Services announced that Harris County Public Library (HCPL) is among 30 finalists for the 2024 National Medal for Museum and Library Science. HCPL is one of three institutions in Texas to be selected as a finalist for the award. The National Medal is the nation's highest honor given to museums and libraries that demonstrate significant impact in their communities. For 30 years, the award has honored institutions that demonstrate excellence in service to their communities.

Ford Road Expansion Project

Entergy has started moving utility poles along Ford Road to make room for expansion of the road. They have also installed some of the wires that will carry the power. Entergy is ahead of schedule on this phase of the road project. CenterPoint has completed plans on moving their utility facilities and will get started soon.
