-50	Bilateral Procedure: This modifer is used when a procedure is performed on both sides of the body during the same session or on the same day. It indicates that the procedure was bilateral, and reimbursement is adjusted accordingly.
-51	Multiple Procedures: This modifer is used multiple procedures are performed during the same session or on the same day. It indicates that additional procedures were performed and may affect reimbursement is adjusted accordingly.
-52	Reduced Services: This modifer is used when a service or procedure is partially reduced or eliminated. It indicates that the procedure was not completed as planned due to specific circumstances and reimbursement is adjusted accordingly.
-59	Distinct Procedural Service Used to indicate that a procedure or service is distinct from another procedure performed on the same day. It's used when procedures are not normally reported together but are appropriate in the given circumstances.
-62	Two Surgeons Used in medical billing to indicate that a surgical procedure was performed by two surgeons, or co- surgeons. Each surgeon reports the procedure using the 62 modifier, and the same surgical procedure code.
