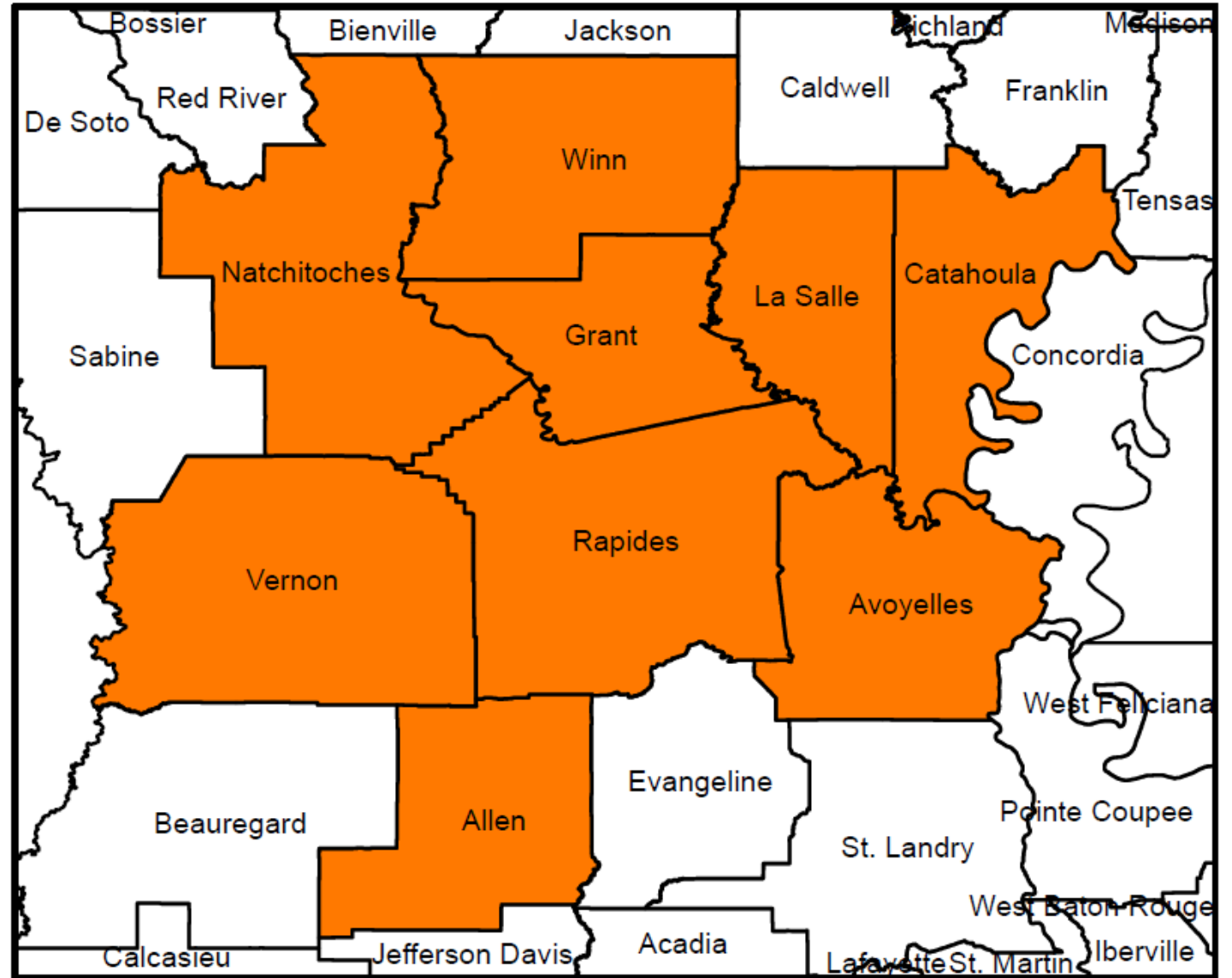

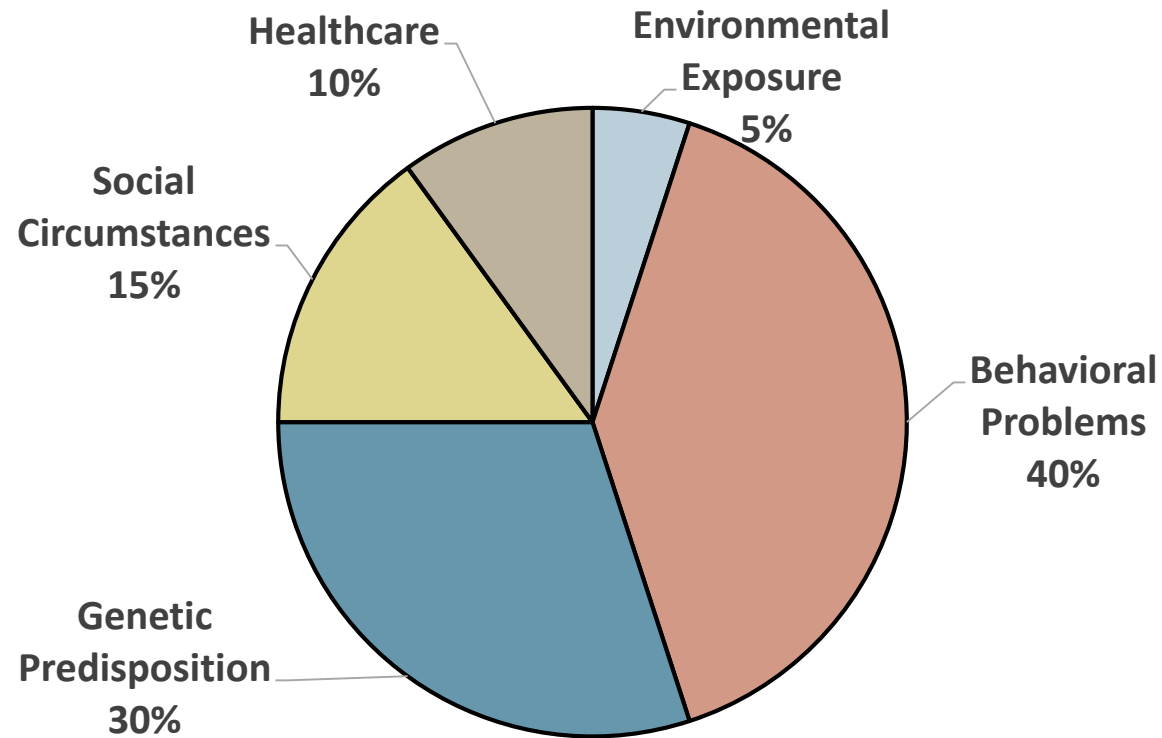

Determinants of Health and Their Contribution to Premature Death



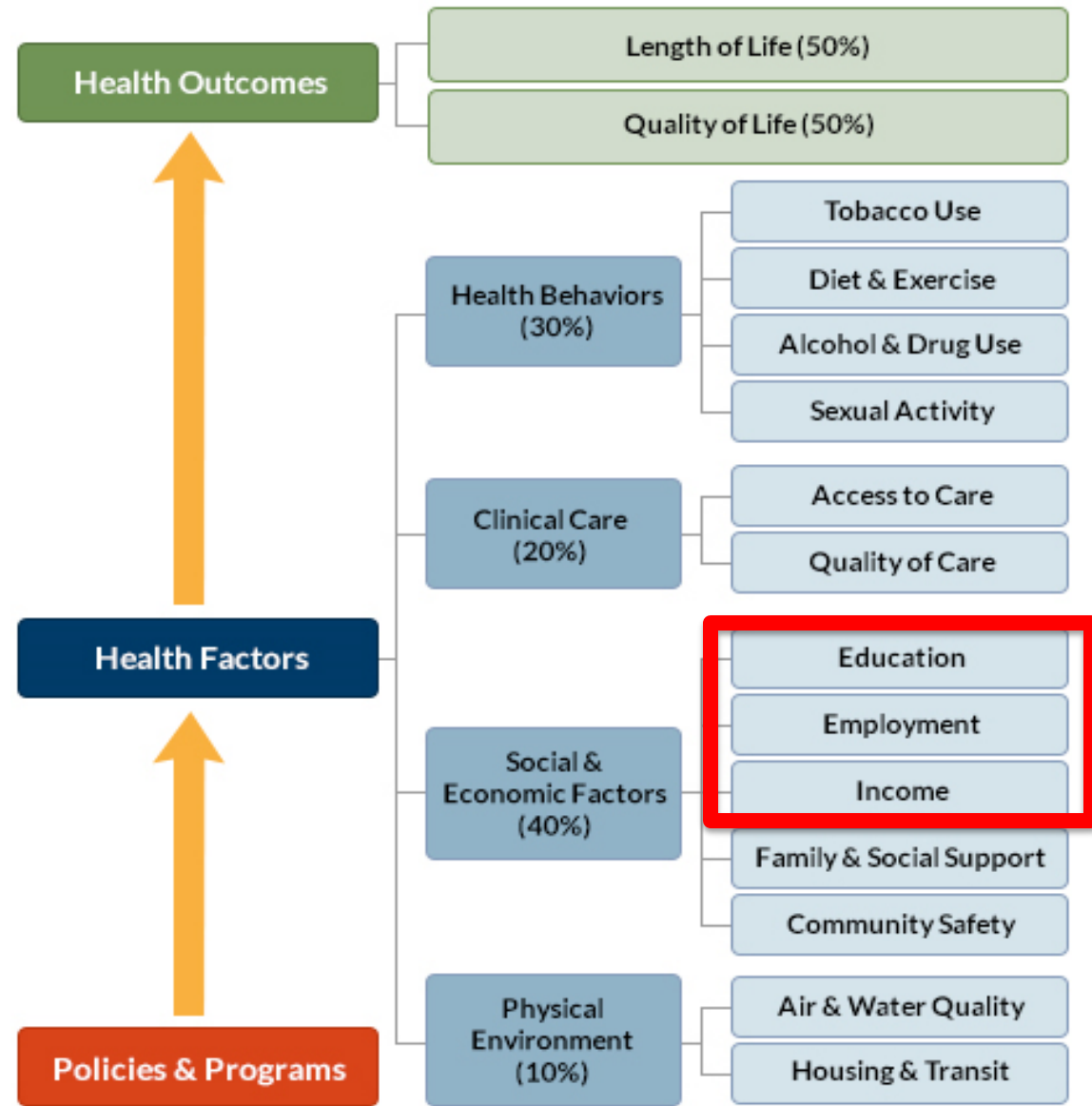
County Health Rankings Model

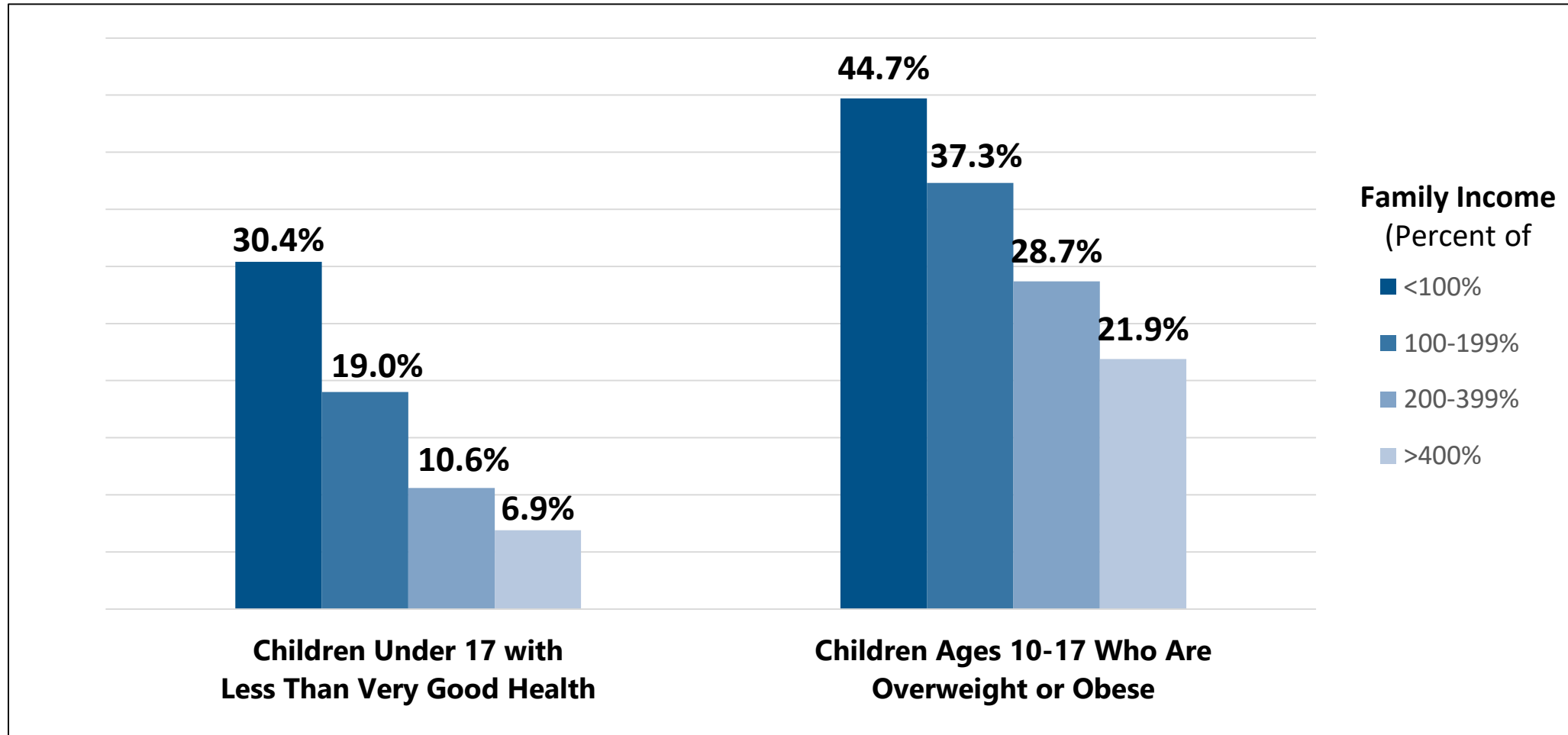

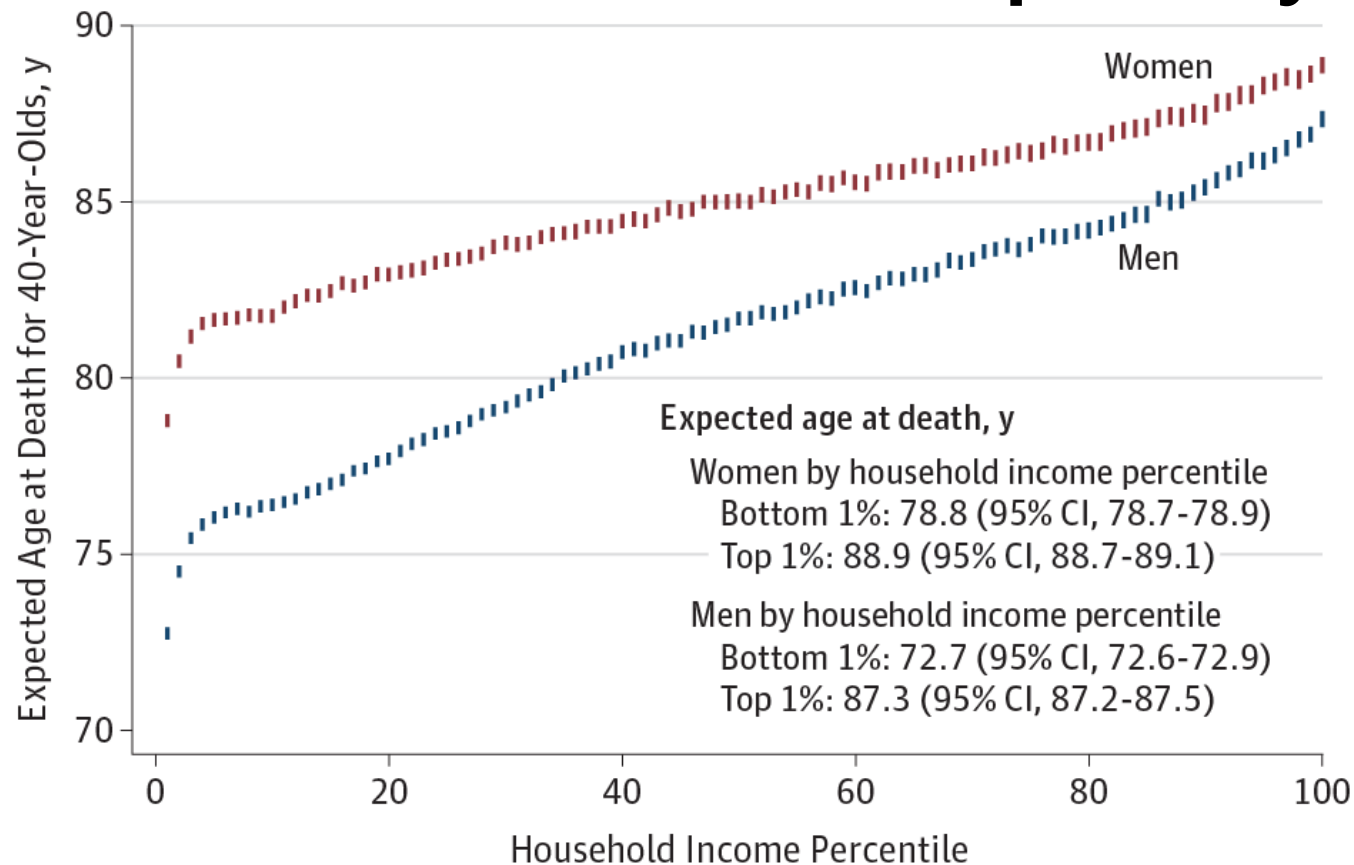


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Association of Income and Healthy Children

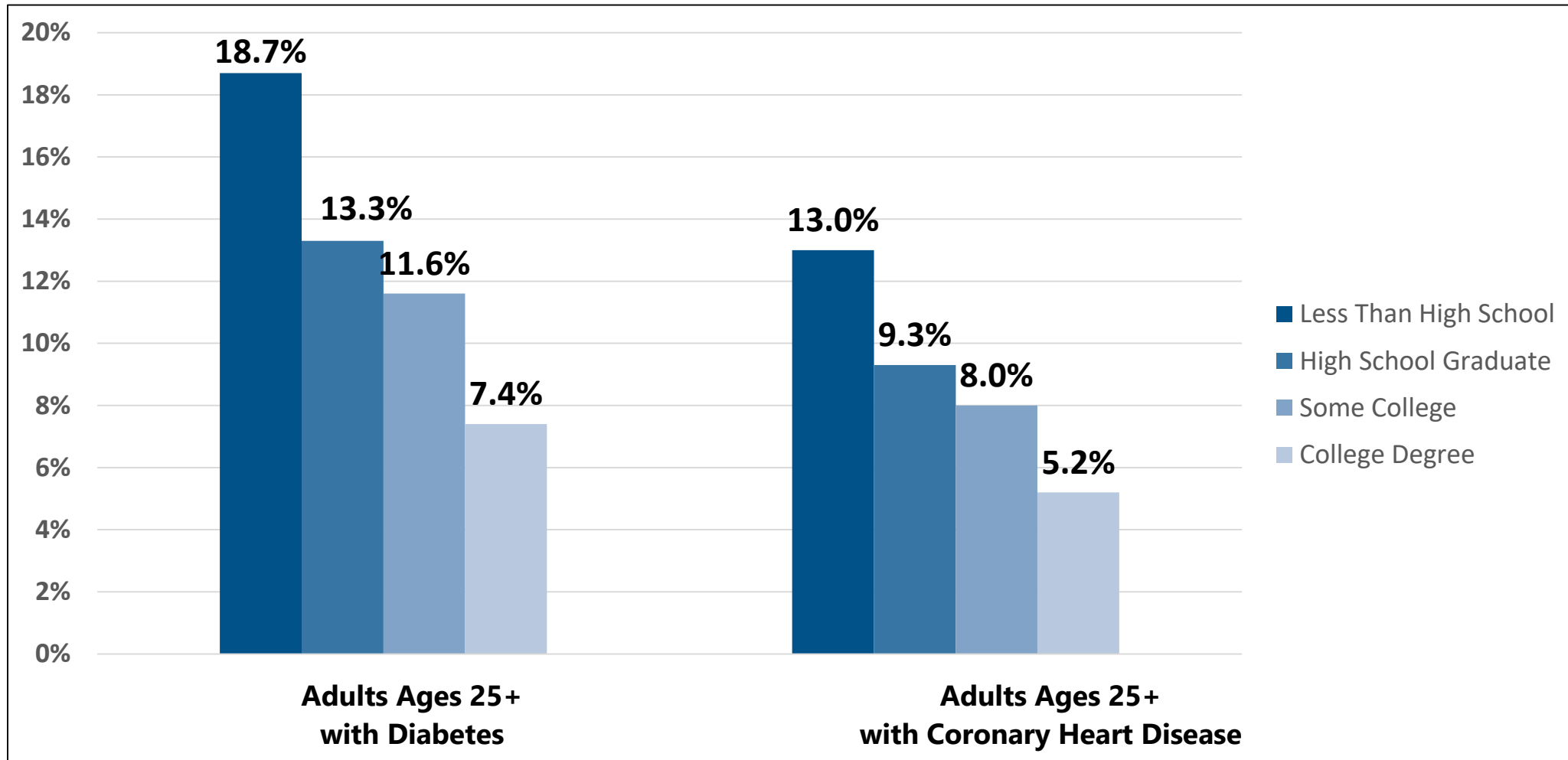

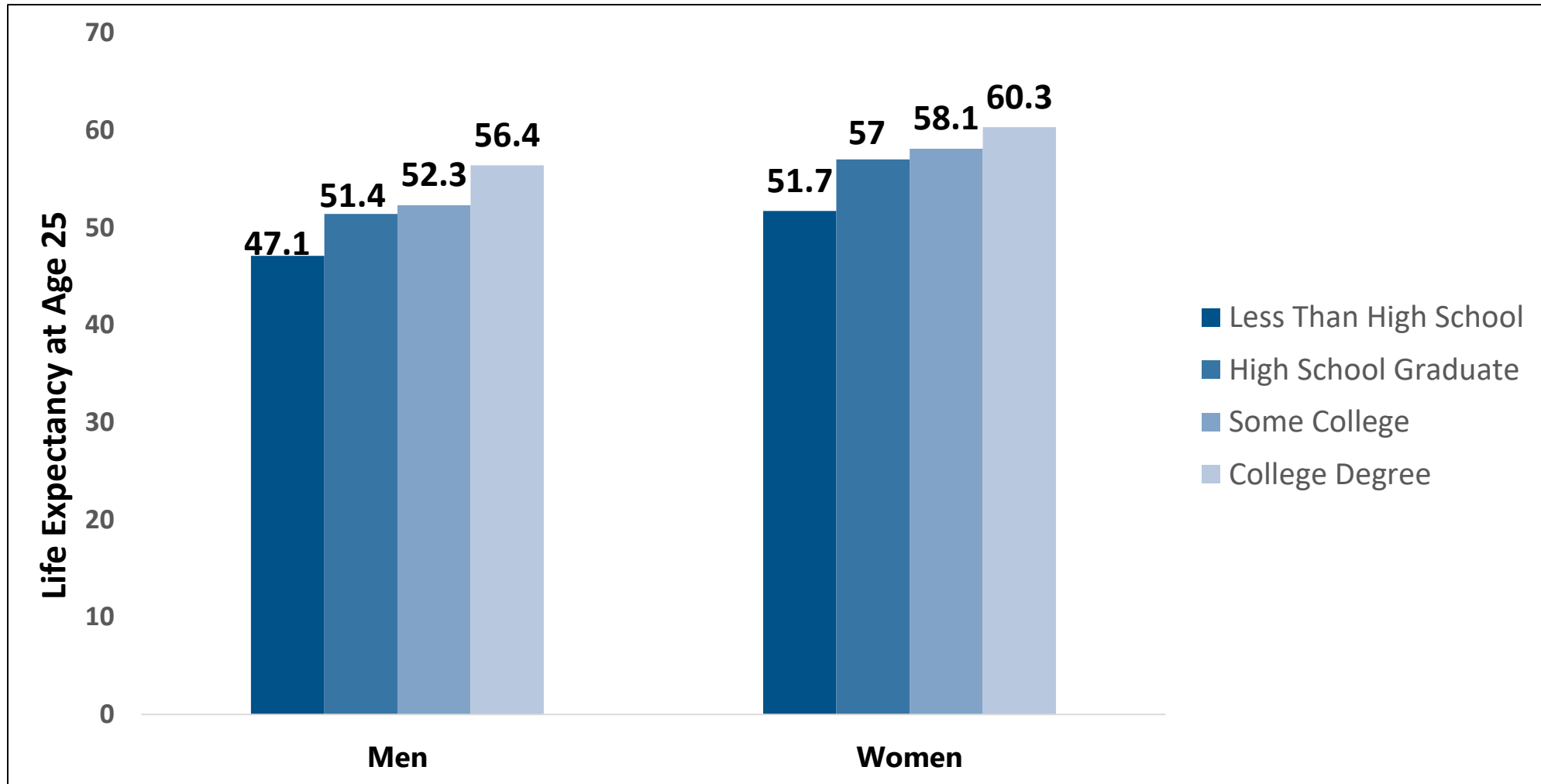

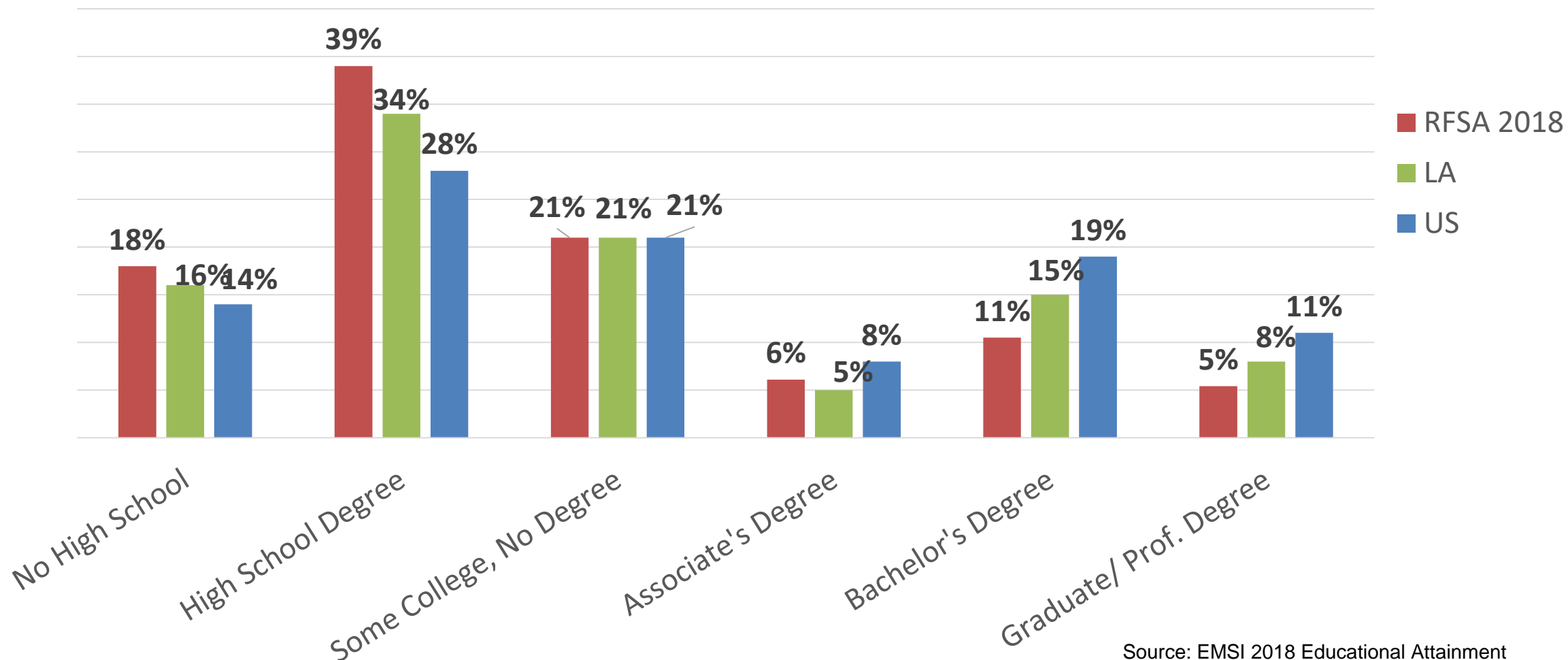

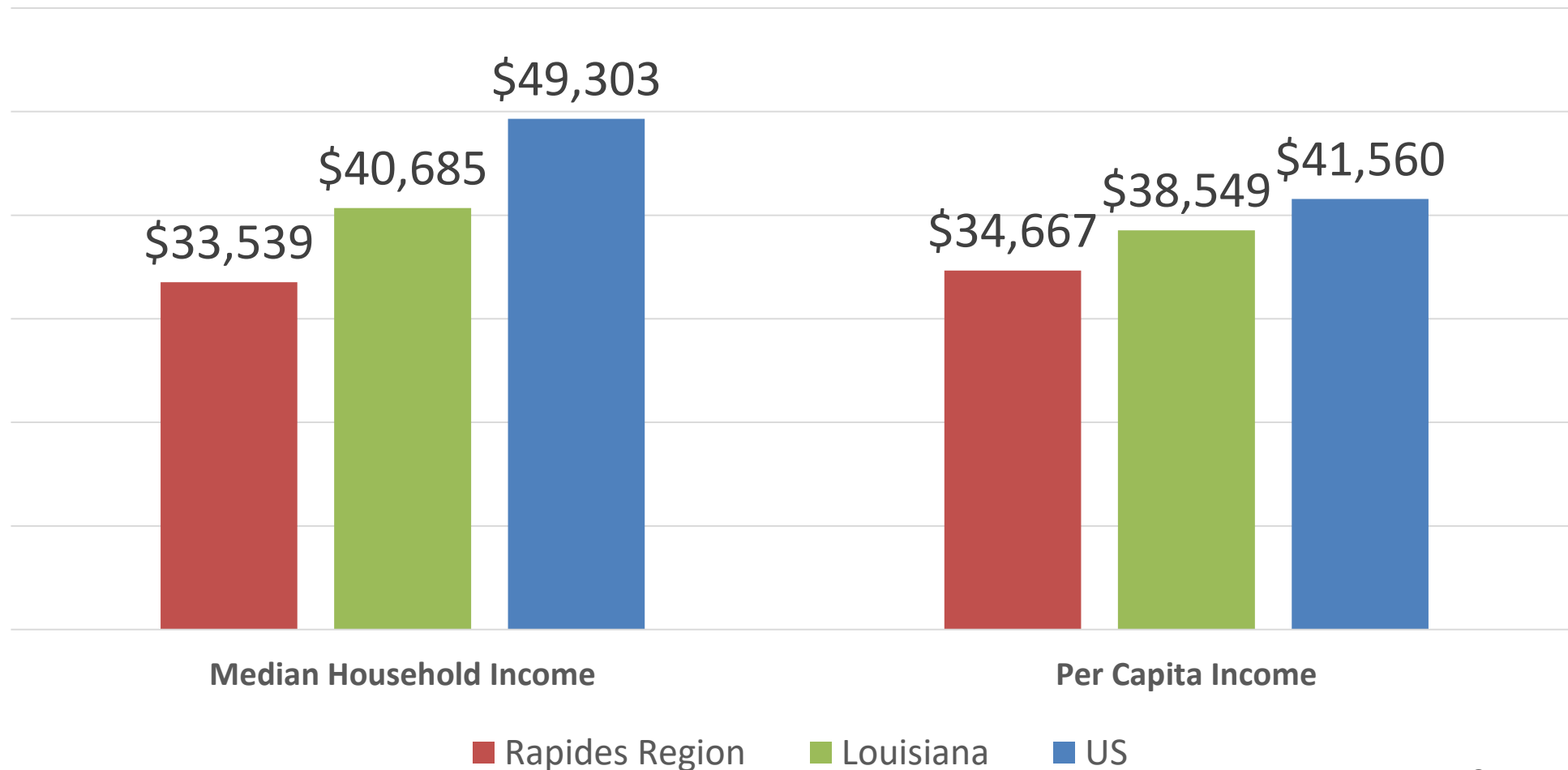

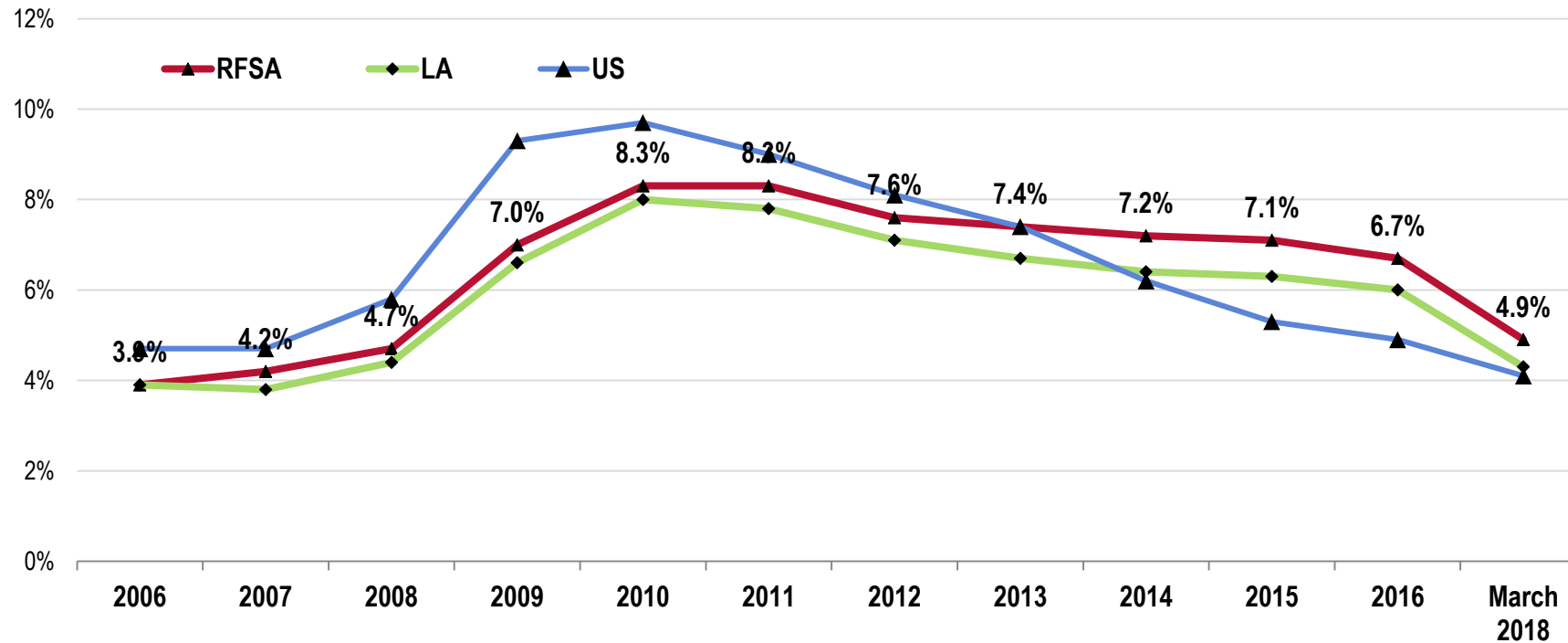
Household and Individual Income, 2016

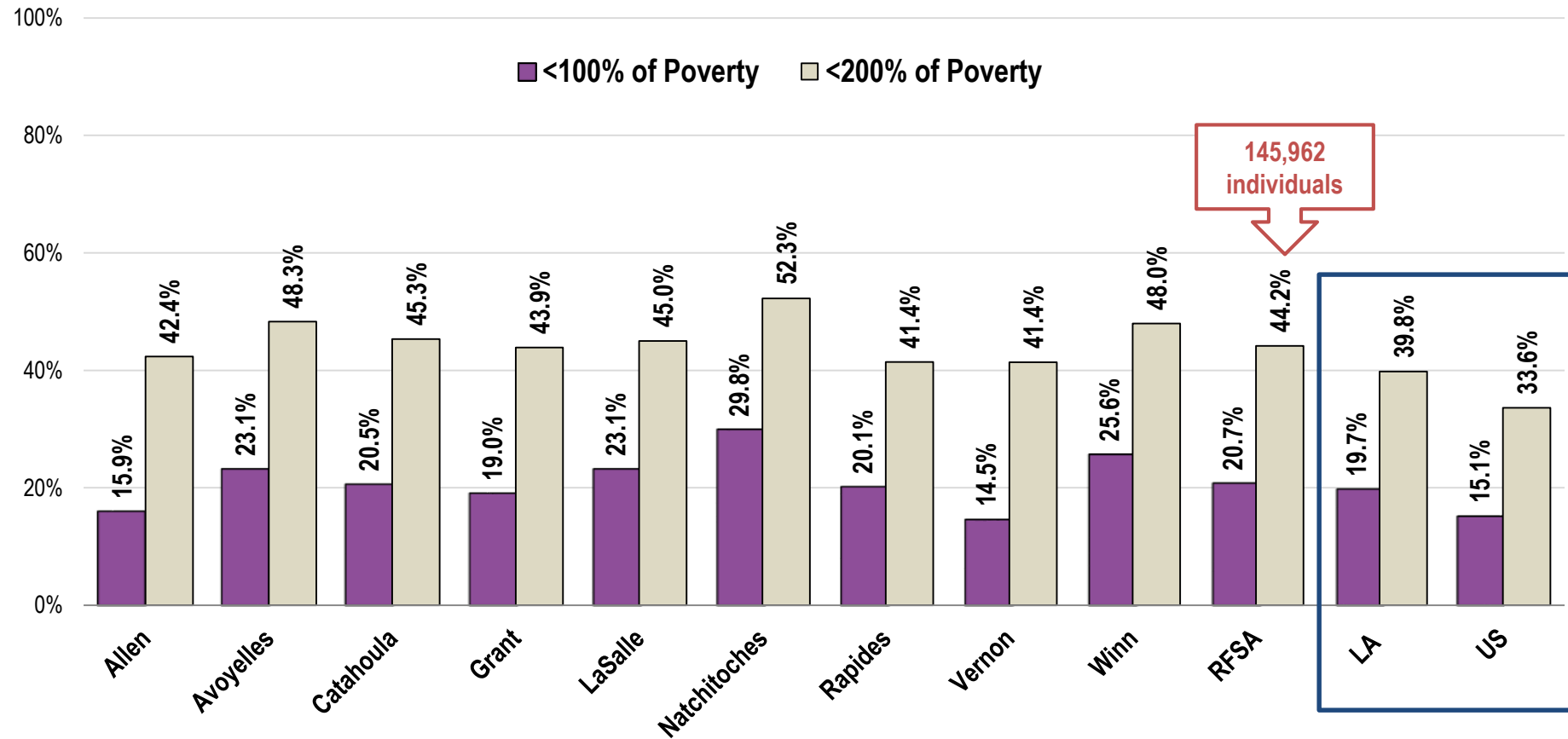

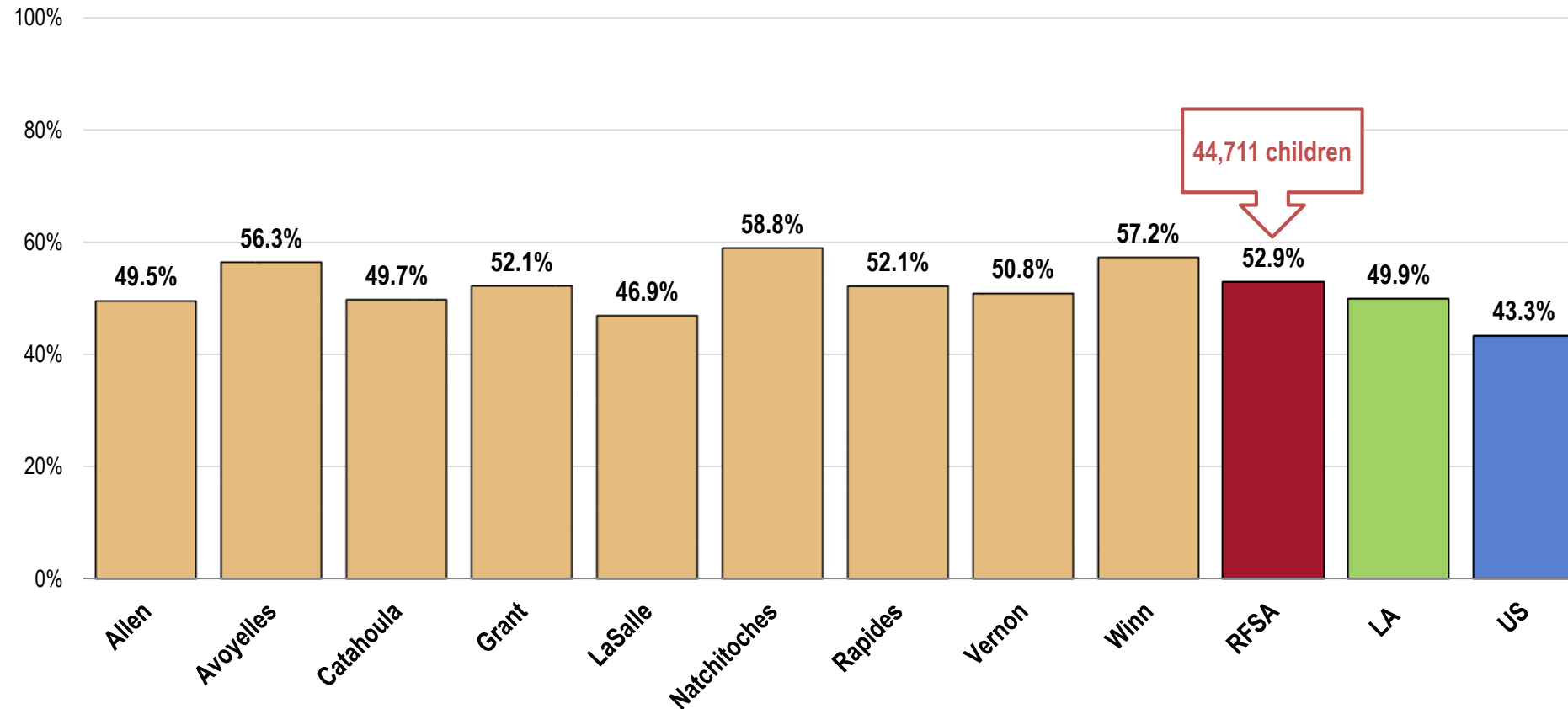

(Children 0-17 Living Below 200% of the Poverty Level, 2012-2016 by Parish)



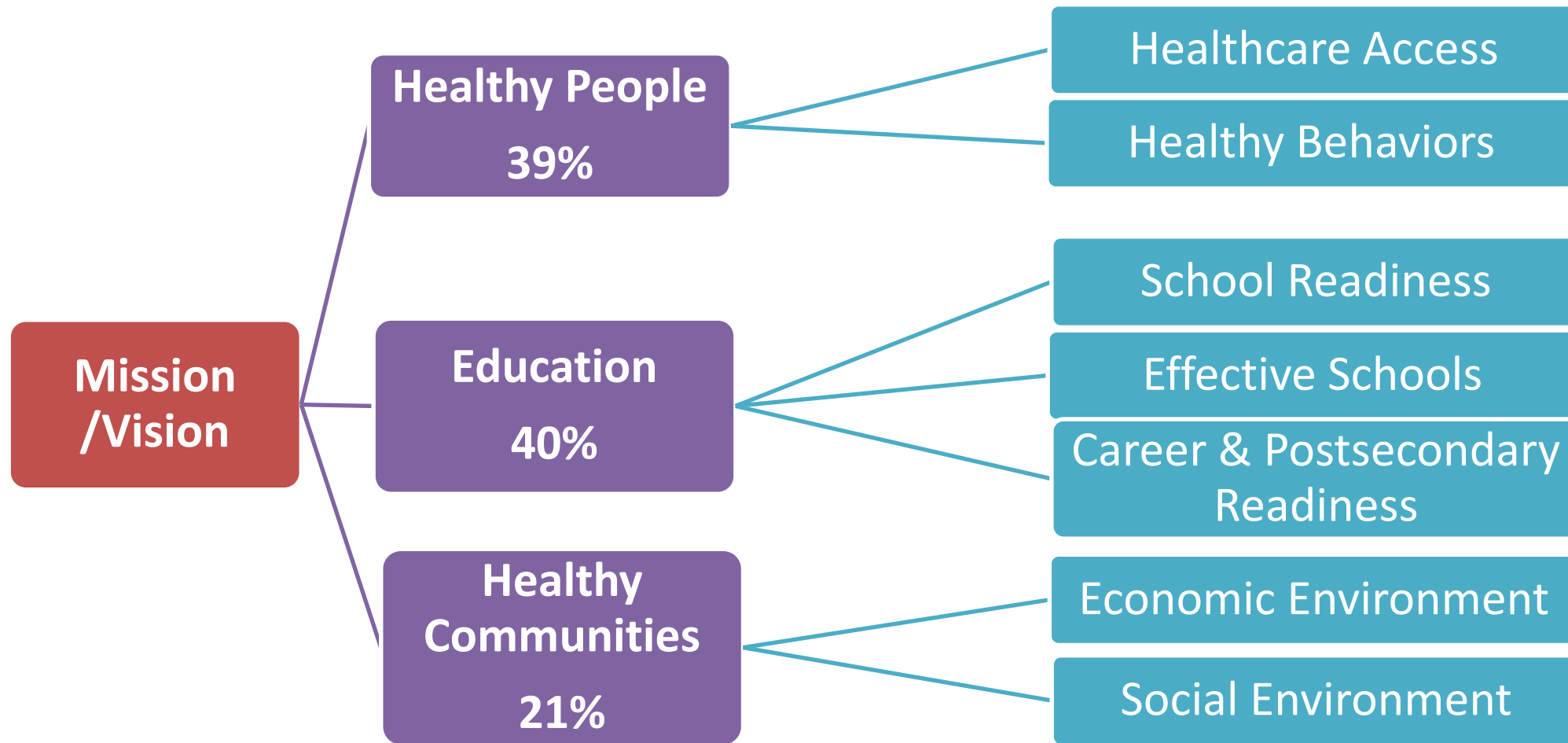

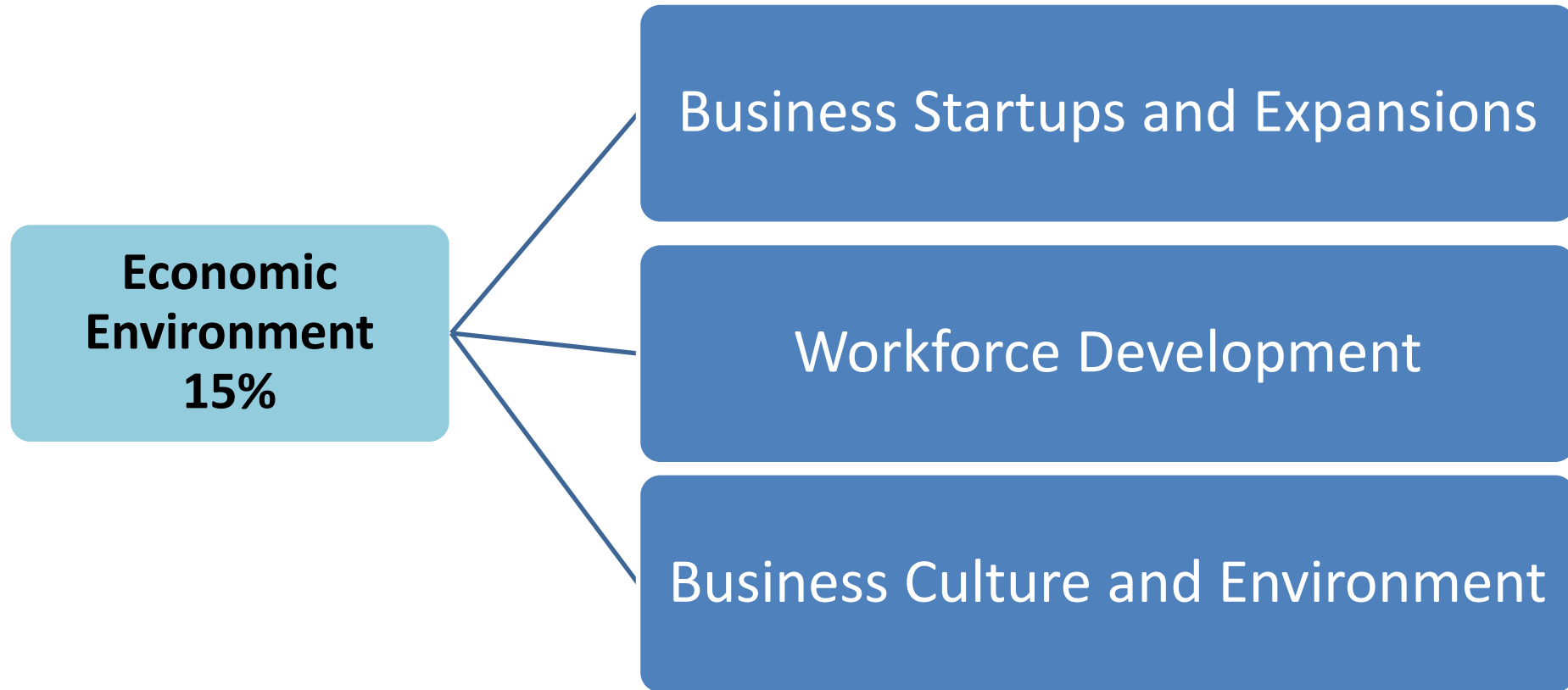


Economic Environment Initiative

- Drives the local economy, bringing in external revenue which can allow the region to prosper.

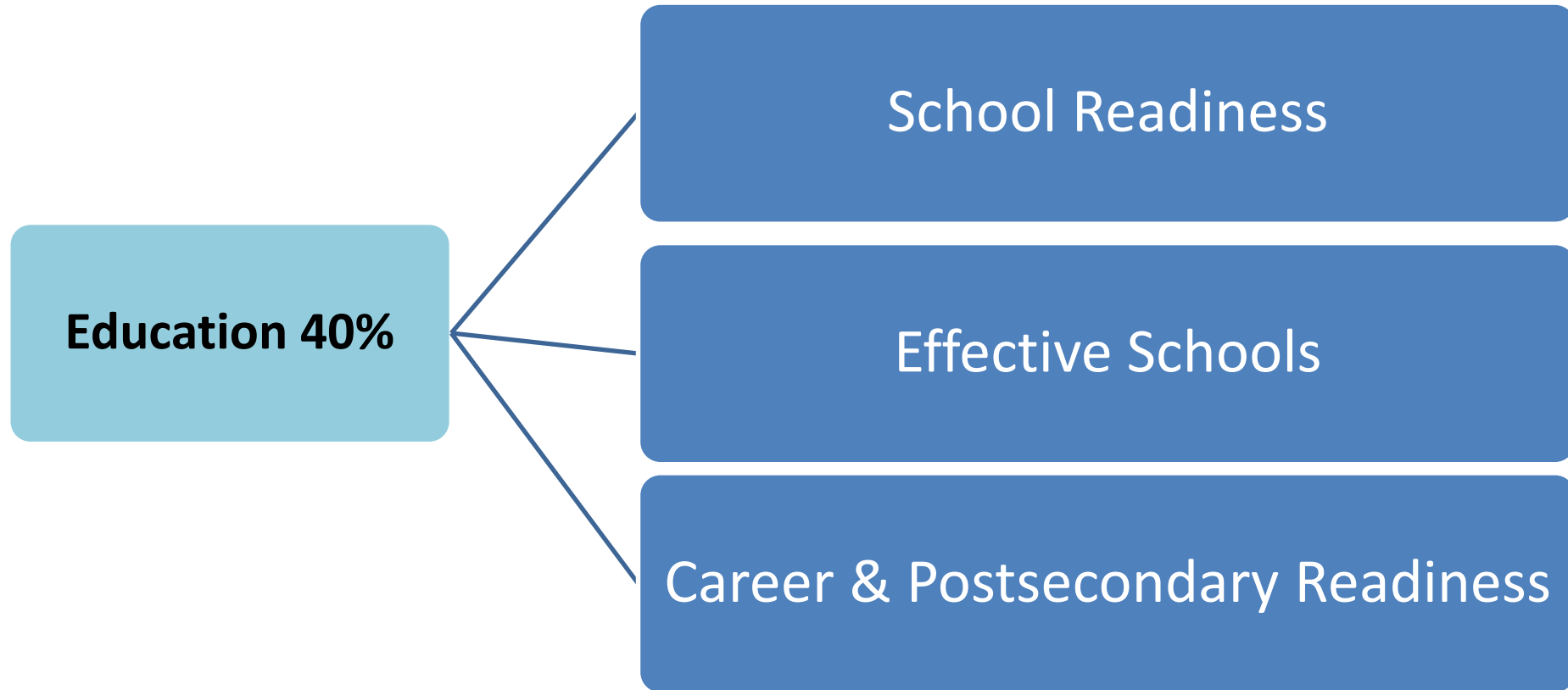


Education Initiative
