THE SIX R's OF PRAYER

A Helpful Outline for Daily Prayer

RECITE aloud a part of the catechism or a bible passage to refresh your memory and focus on your thoughts.

READ this to enrich your understanding of the Lord's teaching.

REFLECT upon how this teaching applies to your faith and life.

REPENT by pouring out your heart to the Lord, asking him to forgive your failures of faith and life. Confess your thoughts honestly to the Lord.

REJOICE in God's mercy and forgiveness through his Son, which are the very basis of prayer. We are unworthy of his blessings, but he declares us worthy through Christ Jesus.

REQUEST God's blessings for yourself as well as your family, friends and neighbors. Pray confidently, in view of the Prophet Isaiah's promise, "The Lord Will Answer." (Isaiah 58:9). *(from "A Daily Prayer Catechism: The Lord Will Answer" Concordia Publishing: St. Louis. 2004, p. I)*

A weekly study of the scripture readings for the upcoming Sunday worship service.


Thursday Mornings @ 10:30am, Sanctuary

Cooperative Extension is now accepting applications for the **Catawba County Youth Council**. The council involves 30 teens who are selected as representatives of their high school, including private and home school students. The students have a chance to improve their leadership skills as they meet monthly for educational programs, projects, and learn more about local government and community needs. The Youth Council is a collaborative project of Catawba County government, Cooperative Extension/4-H, and United Way. One of the favorite projects for the group each year involves reviewing and being involved awarding the United Way Youth grant applications. The Youth Council flier with some details is attached. Our office can also provide you with the printed fliers to share with students, if you need some copies.

To apply for Youth Council – students can complete the online Youth Council application at <u>https://go.ncsu.edu/youthcouncil2024</u>

Applications with the letter of recommendation should be completed by October 11. Students in grades 9-11th who reside and/or attend school in Catawba County are eligible to be part of Youth Council. This year we have space to add about 15 new students.
