While working in a law firm, Davis graduated from Duquesne University in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Organizational Behavior and Information Technology. Davis continued her graduate education at Barry University School of Law in Orlando, Florida, earning a Juris Doctor degree.

While working with writers and artists in the entertainment industry, Davis began to work on various literary works. Davis created the Stanley Stray Children's Book Series to entertain children, while teaching valuable life lessons. The first book in the series, Inviting Stanley Stray, was praised by Marvel Comic founder, Stan Lee, creator of Spider-Man, Black Panther, X-Men, Iron Man, Thor, Daredevil, Doctor Strange, the Hulk, and more. Davis, in partnership with Teach for America and AmeriCorps, worked as a Viral /In-Person Lead Instructor. Currently, Davis is participating in the countrywide Stanley Stray Book Tour to promote the love of literacy.
