SECTION 01

Information We Collect

We collect several different types of information for various purposes to provide and improve our services.

Personal Data

While using our website, signing up for cultural experiences, or booking a Career Companion or coaching session, we may ask you to provide personally identifiable information. This may include:

- Email address
- First name and last name
- Phone number
- Professional background or career history (for coaching inquiries)
- Organization name and role (for nonprofit and AI Workforce service inquiries)

Log Files & Usage Data

Society's Bedrock follows a standard procedure of using log files. These files log visitors when they visit the website. Information collected includes IP addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date and time stamp, referring/exit pages, and number of clicks. These are not linked to personally identifiable information and are used for analyzing trends, administering the site, and tracking user movement on the website.

SECTION 02

How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect in various ways, including to:

- Provide, operate, and maintain our website and services
- Improve, personalize, and expand our website offerings
- Understand and analyze how you use our website
- Communicate with you directly or through partners, including for customer service, updates, and marketing
- Process your inquiries and manage Career Companion or coaching bookings
- Manage nonprofit and AI Workforce service inquiries and onboarding
- Send you emails or newsletters if you opt-in
- Find and prevent fraud

SECTION 03

Cookies and Web Beacons

Like any other website, Society's Bedrock uses "cookies" to store information including visitors' preferences and the pages the visitor accessed. This information is used to optimize the user experience. We may also use the following third-party tools:

- Google Analytics — to monitor and analyze site traffic and user behavior
- Calendly or equivalent scheduling tools — for booking Career Companion and coaching sessions
- Email marketing platforms — for newsletter and outreach communications (opt-in only)

You can choose to disable cookies through your individual browser options.

SECTION 04

- The right to erasure — request that we erase your personal data, under certain conditions

- The right to data portability — request transfer of your data to another organization or directly to you
