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The first step to becoming a successful dancer is making a solid commitment to your classes. Strong technique is a key ingredient and class is where you develop that technique. Come to each class prepared to learn and without personal distractions.

Class time is your chance to focus on yourself, so try to leave your concerns or worries at the studio door. True progress is made when you look at each class as an opportunity to become better at what you love to do. Dance full-out, stretch a little farther, become more aware of your technique, and make the most of every class.

Our studio is a safe place for you to be yourself.

Respect for the teachers is essential. Listen to each correction given, whether it's directed at you or another dancer. A correction is an honour; it shows you how much a teacher cares about your progress.

Nothing can stop those students who apply themselves in every class and appreciate their teachers' knowledge and experience.

A Message for Parents

We believe that children's success depends on the support of their parents or guardians. Our programs rely on a positive atmosphere and educational experience for our students and their parents. Cooperation between all parents is expected.

Showing respect—for other parents, the students, and our staff — makes an important impression on the children. You are a role model for your child on how to interact with others in a professional setting.

Some parents may compare their child's progress or class placement to another child's. Watch for this behaviour in your children as well and encourage them to focus instead on their own accomplishments. Looking to other students for inspiration is good; however, making negative comparisons distracts children from focusing on becoming stronger dancers.

Your child's attendance at all classes is imperative. The spirit of teamwork and the lesson of dedication are a big part of our studio's education process.

Parents and teachers may look at a child's learning from different perspectives. However, we believe they share a common goal: to ensure that every child receives the best possible training, both physically and mentally. Mutual respect among our staff and our students' parents provides the children with the ultimate care and education.

With a focus on fun, technique, versatility and excellence, Melissa's Dance Studio and our team of fully qualified staff are committed to creating a safe and nurturing environment where students are encouraged to work hard and develop a love of the performing arts.

We believe that dance training encourages young people to develop a positive self-image. Along with improving coordination skills and developing muscular awareness, dance classes give children the freedom to express themselves through movement whilst learning valuable lessons about respect, commitment, discipline and team work.

The highest educational standards are expected from all MDS staff members. They are lifelong learners who continue to educate themselves through certification programs, teacher-training schools, conferences, online courses and other learning opportunities.

At MDS, our classes are designed to stimulate the enjoyment of dance while laying an important foundation for further training. As the student advances, the variety and intensity of the class work increases. 
Registration

2024 CONCERTS

PRESCHOOL CONCERT: Sunday 24th November MAINSTREAM CONCERT: Friday 29th & Saturday 30th November.

ALL of our students have the opportunity to perform on stage in our end-of-year concert. It is assumed all students are taking part in this performance unless otherwise advised. More information about the concert is available further on in this handbook.

Class Descriptions

CLASSICAL BALLET	A technical and disciplined style of dance providing the basics of correct posture, co-ordination and strength. To be considered for exams, students MUST take a minimum of two ballet classes per week, their normal class plus exam class.
JAZZ	Jazz can encompass everything from Broadway-style choreography to up-to-date commercial styles. A fun class and a great option for dancers of all ages. This is our recommendation for students new to dance.
TAP	Classes focus on technique as well as musicality, rhythm and style. Students learn the latest tap techniques in a fun class.
LYRICAL	A wide-ranging style that can encompass lyrical's soft flowing movements that tell a story through to the sharp and strong motions of contemporary. This is often a popular choice of class for those who want to add a second or third class but don't want to take ballet.
HIP HOP	One of our most popular class styles, hip hop is a modern street style that is fun and fast paced.
ACROBATICS	Designed to help students achieve strength, flexibility and acrobatic skills. Students will learn elements such as cartwheels, handstands, walkovers and balance skills.
KINDY COMBO	A class designed specifically for our students starting Kindy at 'Big School' in 2024. This class is 90 minutes in length and encompasses all three main styles of jazz, tap & ballet.



Dance Classes for Preschoolers



Ready Set Dance is the most popular preschool active.

Australia, and MDS is proud to be your official location. It is endorsed by early learning experts with classes for 2-3 year olds & 4-5 year olds. These classes a combination of jazz, tap, singing and movement, working on the 3C's: Confidence, Co-Ordination and Creativity.



Ready Set Ballet is a thirty minute magical ballet class for your preschooler. This classes uses gender neutral music with cues, props to enhance the learning experience and encourages children to use their imagination.



A preschool acrobatic program designed with industry leader Acrobatic Arts. An emphasis is placed on safe and effective progressions to build strength, flexibility and skills.



A music and movement class for toddlers and their grownup. Engage, Explore and Express with your toddler in a 45 minute class full of fun and learning.



Class Placement & Ages

You can read the chart below to help you decide which class or classes your child is best suited in. We feel it is important that children dance in the same age group as their friends and that they continue to progress together. This gives the student a sense of familiarity and keeps dance fun for them.

In some cases however, students may be placed in classes outside their age group.

Decisions about class placement are based on the best interests of the student and the Director's decision is final. We do not feel a child should be placed in a particular group or class where we it may have negative effect on self-esteem. Some students who are placed in a higher level can become discouraged, only to lose their passion for dance.

Others respond to the challenge of being in a class with students who are more proficient by pushing themselves to work harder. We closely monitor all of our students as they progress throughout the year.

Class Schedule

Our timetable has been designed so students can participate in multiple classes on the same day/afternoon.

In the table opposite, you can read more about how we categorise our classes and which types of classes might be suitable for your dancer.

Our RECREATION MAINSTREAM dancers love learning to dancers fun environment with a few performance opportunities like our midend of year concerts. Students who take any of our non-exam clasare categorised as RECREATION MAINSTREAM.

EXAM STREAM

exam can provide. Students who take a ballet exam class categorised as Exam students. All of our ballet classes are exam in 2024. It is your decision however if you'd like your child to take these exams. You will be given plenty of time to decide.

PRESCHOOL STREAM

Members of our PRESCHOOL STREAM are aged between 2-5 years old and aren't at school yet. All our preschool classes are part of the Ready Set Dance program.

FITNESS STREAM

Our fitness stream is for dancers who want to build some extra strength and flexibility. These classes are aimed at, but not limited to, our competition stream students and exam stream students. These classes draw on Pilates and the esteemed Progressing Ballet Technique.

Exams

Ballet Exams are optional for Recreation Mainstream students and compulsory for ballet, lyrical and contemporary competition teams and soloists. However, we do strongly encourage participation for interested students. MDS follows the Australian Teachers of Dancing (ATOD) system of training, which is internationally reknowned as one of the best progressive ballet systems. MDS has consistent high marks across all grades with ATOD.

Not only do exams give students a goal to work towards in class, they also give an immense sense of achievement to the student and lead to professional qualifications recognised worldwide.

All of our ballet classes in 2024 are exam classes, however it is up to you whether you would like your child to take the exam. You will receive plenty of notice and guidance to make a decision about this.

There is an exam fee which will be issued well in advance of the exam taking place. A seperate exam uniform is also required to be purchased.

As soon as exam dates are confirmed with us, students will be notified, but we try to aim around mid-August each year for them to take place.



Annual Concert

Our annual concerts are the culmination of each year and gives all students the opportunity to perform on stage in a professionally-equipped theatre. We hold two separate concerts - one for our preschoolers and two for our Mainstream students.

Our 2024 Preschool Concert will be held at the Griffith Regional Theatre approx 24th November.
Our Mainstream Concert will be approx 29th & 30th November.

There are necessary costs involved in the production such as costume fees and these are advised in a timely manner.



MDS is reknowned for putting on a professional production each year. It is always a fun and stress free experience for all involved.

Our timeline of our concert preparation is as follows:

Mid-End Term 2: Costume Deposit invoices are sent out and direct debits will be drawn on 1st July. This is deposit is non refundable, however you will be given ample notice to opt in or out of the concert.

Term 3 Commencement: Students begin learning their concert routines

Mid Term 3: Remaining costume costs are invoiced and date set for direct debits to be withdrawn.

Term 4 Commencement: You will receive your concert guide which includes details of ticket sales, rehearsal and concert performances.

Mid Term 4: Concert Package invoices sent out and direct debits scheduled to be drawn. This is to purchase you concert t-shirt and video footage of our performances and is compulsory.

Week before concert: Rehearsal takes place.

Costumes

At MDS we believe your costume is just as important as your performance!

As such, we take great pride and care in selecting costumes that are not only appropriate for the routine but also ones that will stand out on stage and are flattering and age-appropriate for our students.

We source our costumes from a number of manufacturers both locally and overseas and don't believe it's in anyone's interest to scrimp on quality. We endeavour to keep our costume costs down, however costs do fluctuate from year to year due to influences beyond our control such as shipping, postage and handling.

The only other thing left to purchase for your costumes is stockings, which will be advised with plenty of notice for you to purchase through our dance wear store online.

Fees Policy

This is a summary of our Fees Policy. Please read & agree to the full policy on our website (under the Policies tab) before registering.

- 1. Fees are paid weekly via direct debit. We use the EziDebit payment system. You will receive a direct debit authorisation form upon enrolment. This is a non negotiable form od payment, and your enrolment is confirmed only upon acceptance of this payment method.
- 2. Fees will be deducted from your account every Monday unless a different day is specified by you.
- 3. All classes are to be paid for whether attended on or not for the entirety of the term enrolled.
- 4. If you wish to pay at different intervals, eg fortnight, monthly or by term, this can alos be done on your ezi debit authorisation form.
- 5. Class absences are non refundable.
- 6. Classes cancelled due to teacher absence will be made up at the end of each term in school holidays, as are any public holiday classes that fall on a dance day. Fees are forfeited if you cannot attend the make up classes.
- 7. There is a registration fee of \$20 per child on enrolment to cover administration & insurance. Enrolment is not confirmed until registration is paid.



Uniform

- 3. Any personal items such as clothing and shoes left after class are placed in our Lost Property. Anything left at the end of each term is donated to charity.
- 4.Recording of any classes is strictly prohibited without the express permission of the teacher. Any video taken must NOT be posted to any form of social media.
- 5.Report all accidents and injuries to the teacher and staff at the front Reception desk immediately. All accidents and injuries must have an accident / injury report registered.
- 6. Students are required to clean up after themselves and maintain neat and clean studios, change rooms and toilets.

- IF the class is taking turns to practice an exercise, I will watch my classmates without interrupting so everyone has the chance to learn.

- IF I am late, I will apologise to my class teacher by speaking to them personally before joining the class.

- I WILL always be dressed in correct uniform (including tights) and ensure I have the correct shoes for each lesson, every lesson.
- I WILL ensure my hair is in a neat style that does not fall in my face or require me to "re-do" it repeatedly during class.





Can I do a trial before I enrol?

Absolutely yes! However for legal and safety reasons anyone participating in a trial class must still enrol online so we have all your child's important information readily available to us if we need to contact you. New students to MDS are welcome to trial as many classes as they like for 7 days for free. Please make a note on registration that your are trialling your chosen classes for a week. (PN, this is open to new students only)

Can parents and siblings watch class?

We don't allow anyone other than students in the studio during classes however we do have class viewing weeks at the end of Terms 1 & 3 and a mid year performance at the end of Term 2.

How do I keep up to date with all the studio happenings?

We send out newsletters via email every 2-4 weeks. We won't bombard you, we will only send out a newsletter when needed.

We also have a closed MDS Family Facebook group which will be up and running from mid January 2024.

We also have our studio social media accounts on Facebook and Instagram and love it when our parents & students tag us so we can share in your child's dance journey with us.

Does MDS offer 'boys only' classes?

All of our classes are choreographed for boys and girls. If your son is concerned about dancing in a female dominated class, send him along with a friend. Our preschool program uses gender neutral music, and we take great care in selection of class choreography and music wherever boys are enrolled.

Can I do a makeup class if I am absent?

Yes. Find a similar class on the timetable and let the director know that you will be attending. Make up classes can be taken for missed classes due to illness, travel or personal reasons. Missed classes may be made up within the current term only. Refunds and credits will not be given if your child misses a class and doesn't attend a make up.

What if my child doesn't like a class?

We offer a money back guarantee on all weekly classes within the first week. **See p29 for our refund policy**. It is important to know that at times young children will explore the limits of attending class and say they don't want to go. This period may occur anytime but is usually short-lived. Some ideas that might help you handle the situation: emphasise what the child is doing at the dance class rather than what you do while they are in class; avoid long good-byes; expect the tears and know that usually they are for the parent's benefit.

Do timetables stay the same for the entire year?

Timetable may be subject to change depending on registrations. In the lead up to our concert some classes may be combined.

Are children supervised between classes?

Yes but MDS accepts no responsibility for students outside their class times. Students must be collected promptly from studio door or waiting room.

Is there parking available?

Yes but we ask all parents to remember we are sharing our carpark with a number of other businesses. Please drive safely and ensure you are not blocking any driveways, roller door or entrances to our neighbours. The only allocated parking area for MDS is out the front in the carpark. Do not park on the sides of the building due to entry and walk ways for students.
