SCHOOL RULES.

1. I am proud of my school and as a proud young lady of Soneike Private School (Middle and high school) , I will strive to:

- Be neat and tidy at all times, have clean, unpolished nails no longer than my fingertips,
- not wear make-up, lip gloss colour or highlight my hair. I will not wear any hair beads.
- make sure my hair is always neat and tidy. Tie my hair up if it is too long and not clip my fringe back next to my eyes. If I wear hair extensions it may not be longer than shoulder blades. Each extension may not be thicker than 0,5cm in diameter, no coloured braids or 'dreadlocks',
- Save color braids for when I have left school and never colour or highlight my hair,
- the school maintains the right to discuss any unacceptable hairstyles with the relevant pupil and parents. Please use your discretion in this regard. Make sure your daughter's hair is always neat,
- only use Soneike colors hair accessories,
- wear my dress at a respectable length i.e. When kneeling my dress will be no more than 8 cm above my knees,
- On cold days I will not wrap a blanket around my waist,

2. I am proud of my school and as a proud young man of Soneike Private School, I will always strive to:

- Keep my hair short, (must follow the contour of my head) not touching my collar and trimmed above my eyebrows. I will cut no lines or patterns in my hair or eyebrows, no coloured braids or 'dreadlocks',
- the school maintains the right to discuss any unacceptable hairstyles with the relevant pupil and parents. Please use your discretion in this regard. Make sure your son's hair is neat at all times,

- save braids for when I have left school and never colour or highlight my hair,
- not wear jewelry,
- to wear the correct uniform as instructed by the school.

3. As boys and girls of Soneike Private School we will only:

- Wear jewelry (medic-alert bracelets) if so, prescribed by a doctor. I also give any staff member of my school the right to confiscate and store for safe keeping any form of jewelry which I may wear.

4. We are proud of our school uniform and therefore undertake to:

- Wear it with pride,
- wear only the prescribed uniform at all times, e.g. jerseys, jackets, trousers and socks,
- wear a Golf shirt or `school grey Tshirt with a tracksuit. Mainly white trainers and no secret socks may be worn. I must wear white socks,
- Wear only a tracksuit in term 3.
- wear blazer every day in term 2 and 4,
- wear a pullover with my blazer all the time, the school has the right to confiscate my pullover if I wear it without a blazer and only release it by paying R50. R50 will be added to the school fundraising funds for school sport and awards.
- mark all our clothing, shoes and other belongings clearly and look after it. I know the school is not responsible for my belongings,
- change into sport clothing during the extramural active time.
- I will wear my tie everyday in term 1, 2 and 4. Failure to the card system will apply which will result in a serious consequence.
- I will never wear a shirt that is not a Soneike color shed or grey socks with no lines. If I do that card system will apply which will result in a serious consequence.

5. As learners of Soneike Private School we strive to respect the property of others and the property of our school. Therefore, I will:

- Not damage school property e.g. Laptops, apparatus, media books and scripts. If necessary, my parents will be responsible for costs involved in the repair of damages. Graffiti on school property is strictly prohibited,
- not vandalize plants, trees or gardens on the way to and from school. I realize that a criminal charge can be brought against me if I damage property.

6. **It is also important for me as a learner to:**

- Be at school on time (7:30) for school each day.

7. **To maintain order and discipline at my school:**

- we shall place our school bags in a line neat all time in the classroom,
- When the bell rings before break we will proceed directly to the class.

we may not play in the corridors, in front of the classes or staircases during break.

8. **We must create a learning environment at our school and always be aware of the fact that disciplined pupils will project a good image outside. Therefore:**

- We will be considerate towards our fellow pupils by not disrupting classes and depriving them of their fundamental right to learn. We will not wander around without permission or without the proper identification given by my teacher.
- When the bell rings at the end of a period, we will wait for the teacher's command before we pack up and leave the class.

9. **We will also:**

- I will not have my cell phone with me during school hours as indicated by the school cell phone policy. If my phone is confiscated it will be taken and a R100 fee is payable to get it back. I may leave my phone at the front desk.
- not hold the school responsible for lost cell phones,
- not bring pets, toys or any dangerous objects like knives, cricket bats and balls to school, no alcohol, drug or any sort or vaping at school,
- not barter at school,
- not buy or sell anything from or to fellow pupils or strangers at school,
- not throw any objects e.g. stones around on the playground or in class,
- not play dangerous games at school and not go to the tuck shop without permission or at any time other than breaks,
- not behave badly at any time or use foul language. This includes sexual harassment which is viewed as serious misconduct at our school,
- not to have pornographic material in my possession.

- Not use any language in school beside the english. Afrikaans can be used when it is an afrikaans period.

10 **At the end of the school day we will:**

- leave our classroom neat and tidy, Pick up papers in our classroom, and on the school grounds,

Pupils who are using private transport loop

- Private transport pupils using only Front Gate (GATE 2) , the gate leading to the packing , must make sure all the transport children leave the classroom straight to the gate , not to the tuckshop. The private transport must leave exactly 5 minutes after the final bell.

11. **Pupils who walk home:**

- I will only use Gate 1 to leave the school.
- I will walk in groups on the sidewalk.
- I will not expose myself in public (urinate).

12. **If my parents fetch me from school:**

- I will not go pass the tuck shop and I will leave the school grounds at the small gate , Gate 1.
- I will ask my parents not to park on the opposite side of the road as I will then have to cross on my own and any accident resulting from this will be their responsibility,
- I will ask my parents not to park to Engen garage as this is private property and cause lead to my parents car being clamped
- ask my parents not to park in public parking for more than 30 minutes as that will result in the tick issued to my parents.

13. **A neat school attracts attention, therefore I will:**

- Make sure that my school grounds are always tidy,
- look after the plants and gardens in the school grounds,
- make sure that the classroom, toilets and other buildings are always neat and tidy,

- pick up any papers on the school grounds and make use of the dustbins,

14. **Self discipline and pride are essential ingredients for success therefore my teachers and parents can expect the following from me:**

- I will always do my homework,
- be well prepared for tests and exams,
- to work hard in class and carry out all instructions to the best of my ability,
- have all my test/exams signed by my parents,
- to respect my friends and staff members,
- never to leave the school grounds without permission,
- to behave in a way that does not embarrass my family or school,
- never to bunk as I realize what the consequences can be,
- not to pretend I am ill in order to miss a test/exam. If I am off school/ill I will supply a note from my doctor.
- To never gossip about my peers.
- I understand All students have the right to an education free of interference, intimidation and/or physical abuse. I will respect the property and safety of other students. Fighting or threatening other students is forbidden.

15. **I will keep myself clear of areas that are indicated as “out of bounds”. These include:**

- The school parking lots, except during drop-off and pick-up times.
- Electrical mains distribution boxes and fire extinguishers.
- Areas that are allocated to a specific phase or grade.
- Switching on and off the aircon.
- To Store room

If I adhere to the rules as set out above, I will create a relaxed and enjoyable environment for all to work and learn in perfect harmony.
