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Important Notice:

By enrolling your child at Soneike Private School, you acknowledge and accept our Uniform Policy and guidelines.

Uniform Requirements

- All students must wear the designated uniform for their grade level.
- Uniforms must be clean, ironed, and in good condition.
- Unauthorized items will be confiscated and returned to parents at the end of the term.
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Refer to Uniform Guidelines Document for specific details on uniform requirements.

Civvies Day Attire

Civvies days are optional and require a small fine for participation

Learners must dress neatly and correctly, avoiding:

- Midriff-baring tops
- Excessive jewelry
- Mini skirts or shorts
- See-through clothing
- Excessively tight clothing

School Outings

- Full school uniforms are required, unless otherwise specified
- Failure to wear the correct uniform may result in exclusion from the outing

Marking of Uniform and Lost Property

- All clothing items must be permanently and legibly marked with the owner's first name and surname
- Unmarked or illegibly marked items will be kept in lost property for two weeks before being handed over to the second-hand shop or donated to charity

Deviations and Exceptions

- Temporary deviations may be granted for medical conditions, injuries, or unforeseen events

- Parents must provide written explanation and supporting documentation
- The principal and stakeholders reserve the right to determine and approve deviations and exceptions

Consequences for Uniform and Grooming Infractions

- Counselling and reprimand
- Correction of the infraction
- Confiscation of incorrect items
- Written reflection
- Disciplinary actions (yellow card, red card, suspension, expulsion)

Responsibilities

- Student Responsibility: To wear the correct uniform and adhere to grooming guidelines
- Parent Responsibility: To ensure their child wears the correct uniform and adhere to grooming guidelines
- Teacher Responsibility: To monitor and enforce uniform and grooming guidelines
