We are celebrating Christ's message to us in this special service culminating our Easter season.






THE TRUTH IS....

“Then he showed me the river of the water of life, bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb through the middle of the street of the city; also, on either side of the river, the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit, yielding its fruit each month; and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations..” (Rev.22:1-2)

Where is this place that is mentioned in John’s vision? Is it really about some far past or future event? For me, and in Unity teachings, it is neither, but it is a depiction of the pure life of God that flows into each of us through our spiritual body, what we call our aura, and is sensed by the our physical body in our cerebrospinal systems. All the interesting and enigmatic things that John saw and wrote of were first an out-picturing of his spiritualized, inspired, soul thoughts, and this wonderful garden is the depiction of our auric body, the substance (temple) of God. Our soul inhabits our body; its emanation is called the aura.

So does this vision have any meaning for us today? Let me offer an interpretation based on Truth teachings.

The throne denotes the establishment of the spiritual word with the soul, through which authority is given us to exercise power and dominion (good stewardship). There is that in us that comprehends and knows in wisdom. There are two ways of building our spiritual faculties. One is by following the guidance of Spirit, the direct power of the Word, the I AM, (the

of the twelve apostles of Jesus), that dwells within, and the other is to learn by the evolutionary law of experience and trial (the school of the twelve sons of Jacob). Charles Fillmore said, "The Law of Moses and the experiences of the Children of Israel under the dispensation represent the second; and the transforming power of the true Word, or gospel of Jesus Christ, as set forth in the New Testament, is the first." Here I am referring to more than just literal, written words, but the embodiment of what those written words convey; the very energy of Spirit in them. For example, living, knowing, and expressing as peace, beauty, power, love, courage, etc.

There are two ways of building our spiritual faculties. One is by following the guidance of Spirit, the direct power of the Word, the I AM, (the purifying of the twelve apostles of Jesus), that dwells within, and the other is to go blindly ahead and learn by the evolutionary law of experience and trial (the school of the twelve sons of Jacob). Charles Fillmore said, "The Law of Moses and the experiences of the Children of Israel under the dispensation represent the second; and the transforming power of the true Word, or gospel of Jesus Christ, as set forth in the New Testament, is the first." Here I am referring to more than just literal, written words, but the embodiment of what those written words convey; the very energy of Spirit in them. For example, living, knowing, and expressing AS peace, beauty, power, love, courage, etc.

The Lamb symbolizes the indwelling divine life, whose nature is to vivify, with perpetual life, all things that it touches. It knows only to give, to give unceasingly and eternally without restraint.


This river of living water is the expression of spiritual thoughts through the soul. The movement of spiritual thinking produces an effect upon the body...a vital energy, a fine essence of life (and of the lamb), which flows through the nerves and courses through the blood. It carries with it the enjoyment for life and the desire to be about living well. Depression is the result of telling ourselves and hearing reinforced only error beliefs, based in unworthiness, unloveable, etc. The more we think and feel from Truth, the more we are physically and mentally uplifted.



The tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruits are ideas of divine life experienced in the body through the nervous system as health, well being, longevity, good humor, etc. As we express and incorporate into our lives the activity of divine ideas, (peace, strength, faith, love, compassion, generosity, etc.), the leaves of the tree that were for healing become the spiritualized thoughts that heal our physical, mental, psychic, and emotional bodies, (the nations) and guide us in our everyday lives and bring forth choices that heal erroneous beliefs and attitudes. When we aren't listening to or following Spirit, the fruit of Spirit falls fallow on the ground, and the leaves, our experience of joy, peace, love, wither and we are left with a yearning for God that we feel, move from or exist in our life solely from duty, obligation or rigid adherence to a set of false appearances and usually find martyrdom, intolerance, and or self-righteousness to be our fruits.

Trees, as a rule bend with the wind and are flexible as well as strong. As you and I listen to the guidance of Spirit and follow it or bend with the wind in faith, we grow up strong toward the light of wisdom and understanding. Faith is a deep inner knowing that that which is sought is already ours. It is the perceiving power of the mind linked with the power to shape substance. St. Augustine said, "*Understanding is the reward of faith. Therefore seek not to understand that you may believe, but believe that you may understand.*" Spiritual Understanding gives clear insight into everything; it remolds mentality, and inspires the will to direct, to act, and to control.


