## The Pastor's Pondering Rev. J. Paul Bruhn



The year is just one month old, and many of us may already have given up on our new year's resolutions. We had good intentions, yet it is very hard to overcome

behaviors that are less than beneficial if we do not find something that will help us to replace that behavior. I would like to provide you with two options.

First, we will celebrate the Mid Texas annual Awakening Conference February 11 to 14 in Frisco, Texas. This year the motto is taken from Exodus, "A Thousand Generations." GOD establishes for the Israelites a better understanding how He will treat them as they are His people. When GOD talks about false gods He explains,

### Exodus 20:5-6 (NIV84)

"You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments."

While the New International Version, 1984 edition is particularly clear concerning the 1,000 generations it is necessary to explore what word GOD is using to describe His love for them. The word love here is better translated 'lovingkindness.' It can also be rendered as 'mercy,' something no one can earn on their own, it is freely given by GOD.

As our annual conference explores how we can build the bridge from the Gospel to our everyday contemporaries of ALL AGES, we need your prayers. Please lift up all the delegates, officers, and presenters, ask the LORD for divine protection as people travel hundreds of miles. Speak already a blessing over their hotels, and B & B's. Pray that all the equipment will be fully functioning and that there will be no failure of the power grid.

It can be as simple as placing a sticky note on your bathroom mirror with the names of your delegates and pastor, so you can intercede for them every morning and evening, and pray for revival in your home town while you are at it.

Second, we will host the Reverend Tommy Hayes with Messiah Ministries. He will teach us prayer as well as different ways to approach healing for our spirit, soul, and body. I like the way the Apostle John describes it at the very beginning of his third letter.

### **3 John 2 (NASB 95)**

Beloved, I pray that in all respects you may prosper and be in good health, just as your soul prospers.

You are called by GOD. He has transferred you from the kingdom of darkness into His Kingdom of Light. And in His 'agape' love -- a love that humans cannot create in and of themselves, but that always originates with GOD -- it is GOD's desire for us to be restored to wholeness in spirit, soul, and body. The more we allow for GOD to touch and restore us the more joyful we will follow our Heavenly Father and take on the works, He has prepared for us to do (Ephesians 2:10 -- in case you wonder.)

We ask that you clear your calendar for February 20 & 21, from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Friday and from 9:00 am to 4:pm on Saturday, with a healing service on Saturday at 6:00 pm.

## *A Note from the Director of Family Ministries*



### **One Hour Isn't Enough—We Need Your Help!**

*Dear Hondo Methodist Church Families,*

What a joy it is to walk alongside you and your children as we explore the greatest story ever told—the story of God's love for us, found in the Bible. Last month was a special milestone in our Kids Church. We introduced our **"Books of the Bible"** curriculum and presented each child with their very own Bible and highlighters. It was beautiful to see their faces light up, holding God's Word in their hands. Our heart is simple: we want every child to know that the Bible isn't just a book for church; it's a personal letter from God to them, filled with truth, hope, and guidance for their lives.

Last month, our kids learned about the structure of the Bible—the Torah (Law), the History books, and the Wisdom books. This month, we're continuing to explore more books, helping them see the big picture of God's redemptive story.

**The goal is intimacy, not just information.** We want our kids to build a lifelong relationship with Jesus, and that starts by knowing His Word. The Bible is the foundation of our faith—it's how we learn God's character, understand His promises, and hear His voice.

- ♥ **Engage with the Take-Home Sheet:** Each week, your child receives a take-home discussion sheet. Please take 10 minutes to look at it with them. Help them find the Bible passage, read it together, and talk about what it means. These conversations are priceless.
- ♥ **Prioritize Weekly Attendance:** Consistency is key! The lessons build on each other, creating a cohesive understanding. By bringing them regularly, you ensure they don't miss the valuable building blocks of faith being laid each Sunday.

When we work together—church and home—we create a consistent message that helps our children's faith take root and grow deep.

### **For Our Youth: "The Table" Breakfast & Bible Study**

We also want to extend a special invitation regarding our youth. In a world that offers our teenagers countless conflicting messages about identity, purpose, and truth, it is more vital than ever that they have a firm foundation.




