

The Pastor's Pondering Rev. J. Paul Bruhn

The leaves are changing their colors – at least in the Wal Mart decorations hidden between the costumes of witches and pirates. Many people already make detailed plans for



Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Years, knowing that invitations have to go out and arrangements have to be made. There is not much left of the lazy, hazy days of summer. In the midst of all the hustle and bustle it seems almost impossible to carve out time for a close and meaningful relationship with our Creator GOD. We know, He should be our #1 priority, but that is easier said than done.

Hence, it might be time to do a rerun of a set of keys available to all believers. Rerun? Yes, because we took a look at it several years ago. I am presenting you with four keys to a closer relationship with our Savior and LORD. I am indebted to Mark Virkler who developed these steps in response to his personal difficulties hearing from GOD, even though, he was convinced that GOD wanted to speak to GOD's children. It was just that the left hemisphere of his brain worked overtime, making it almost impossible to become still and wait upon the LORD (Psalm 46:10).

The best way to provide you with scriptural foundation for this approach is found in one of the books commonly referred to as the minor prophets. Please keep in mind that 'minor prophets' describes the length of individual books, but NOT their importance.

Habakkuk 2:1–3 (NKJV)

- 1 I will stand my watch And set myself on the rampart, And watch to see what He will say to me, And what I will answer when I am corrected.
- **2** Then the Lord answered me and said: "Write the vision And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it.
- **3** For the vision is yet for an appointed time; But at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; Because it will surely come, It will not tarry.

We have 4 basic keys to improve our ability to listen to GOD and receive directions for our daily life.

Key#1

I must learn to still my own thoughts and emotions, so that I can sense GOD's flow of thoughts and emotions within me.



Basically we must attune our inner antennas to GOD's wavelength. Imagine an old-style radio that required the listener to carefully turn a knob until the frequency was just right, excluding all the white noise to the left and the right on the frequency dial.

Key #2

As I pray, I fix the eyes of my heart (Ephesians 1:18) upon JESUS, seeing in the spirit the dreams and visions of Almighty GOD.

Imagine an antique orthodox icon that depicts Jesus as the friend of a saint – and YES, you are a saint the moment you accept JESUS as your Savior and LORD – having HIS arm around the saint's shoulders and sharing what is on HIS heart and mind.

Key #3

GOD's voice in our hearts sounds like a flow of spontaneous thoughts. Therefore, when I tune to GOD, I tune to spontaneity.

Imagine a constant flow of divine revelation originating from the Throne of GOD.

Maybe there is something hindering the flow of the signal, imagine a metal roof interrupting the reception. That roof could consist of unconfessed sin on your end. If so, deal with it immediately. If the signal is clear start writing it down, a.k.a. journaling.

Key #4

Journaling, the writing out of our prayers and GOD's answers.

This allows you to refrain from evaluating GOD's communication until the flow stops and you can take a closer look at the received revelation. Now you can go back and test and examine carefully, making sure everything lines up with the written Word of GOD, a.k.a. the Bible.

Disclaimer:

No one should attempt this without having first read through at least the New Testament (preferably the entire Bible), nor should one attempt this unless one is submitted to solid, spiritual leadership. All major directional moves (e.g. mates, jobs, and dates) that come through journaling should be submitted to some trusted friends in the faith before being acted upon.

I have a key ring with all the keys important to unlock doors in our church. They are in a particular order. While they still function out of order, they are most beneficial when you know how they are arranged. The same is true when it comes to these four keys.

I hope and pray that you are now hungry for more, more of GOD, more of Scripture, and more of GOD's guidance for your life.


A Heartfelt Thanks


