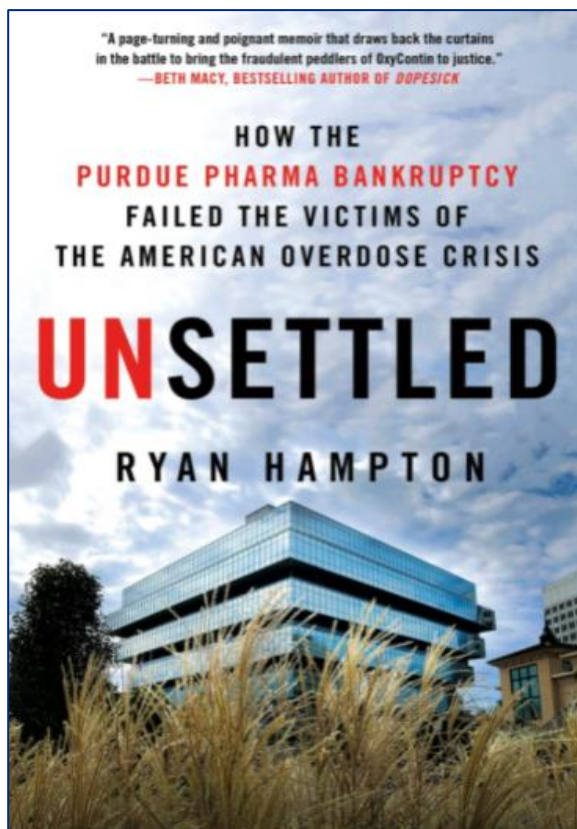

UNSETTLED... The real story of the Purdue Pharma bankruptcy wasn't that the billion-dollar corporation was a villain or serial federal offender. Purdue didn't do this alone. They were aided and abetted by the very systems and institutions that were supposed to protect us. Ryan Hampton served as the co-chair of the official creditors committee representing victims in the Purdue Pharma LP bankruptcy case, and he has a story to tell about how a group of determined, ordinary people tried to see justice done against the odds—and in the face of brutal opposition from powerful institutions.

Ryan Hampton is a prominent advocate, speaker, author, and commentator. In recovery from a decade-long opioid addiction, Ryan has become a prominent, leading face and voice of recovery advocacy and is changing the national conversation about addiction. An alumnus of the Clinton White House, he's worked with multiple nonprofits and national recovery advocacy campaigns.
